B.R. Ambedkar Jayanti :14 April:-

Ambedkar Jayanti is celebrated on April 14th, the birth anniversary of BR Ambedkar. Ambedkar, a social reformer, lawyer, and political activist, is remembered for his contributions to the Indian Constitution and for fighting for the rights of Dalits and the oppressed. He was the chairman of the committee that drafted the Indian Constitution, which was approved on January 26, 1950. He was a lawyer and economist by trade, and he served as Law and Justice Minister in Jawaharlal Nehru's first cabinet.

PM Modi Invited To France For Bastille Day Parade:-

According to sources, France has invited Prime Minister Narendra Modi to attend the annual Bastille Day parade in Paris in July as a guest, but the visit is still being discussed. The visit, which would add to Mr. Modi's already-busy diplomatic schedule, is expected around July 14. As the two countries celebrate the 25th anniversary of their strategic partnership,

the PM and French President Emmanuel Macron are expected to discuss a number of major agreements, including those on the Indo-Pacific region, nuclear power, and defence.

India GDP Growth Likely To Moderate To 6.3% In FY24: World Bank:-

According to the World Bank's report, India GDP growth will slow to 6.3% in FY24 due to lower consumption due to lower income. The World Bank has reduced its forecast for India's economic growth in the current fiscal year to 6.6%. Since May 2022, the Reserve Bank of India has raised interest rates by 250 basis points to combat inflation. "Rising borrowing costs and slower income growth will weigh on private consumption growth," the World Bank said. The World Bank estimated last fiscal year's growth at 6.9%.

Earlier in the day, the Indian men defeated the Sri

Lankan challenger by 45 points in the semi-finals. In the other semi-final, Nepal defeated Bangladesh by 12 points with 1.5 minutes remaining.

India And Romania Sign First Defence Cooperation Agreement:-

Romania's deputy defence minister, Simona Cojocaru, met India's defence secretary, Giridhar Aramane, in New Delhi and signed a defence agreement. The defence cooperation agreement signed by India and Romania will strengthen collaboration through the exchange of expertise and knowledge on topics of mutual interest, such as co-development and co-production of military hardware, according to Simona Cojocaru, State Secretary and Chief of Romania's Department for Defence Policy, Planning, and International Relations.
