
DAILY UPDATE 1 : SPORTS



Indian batter Ishan Kishan hits fastest ODI double hundred off 126 balls:-

Ishan Kishan of India hit the fastest double century in one-day international history with a sublime 210 against Bangladesh. Kishan needed only 126 balls to reach 200, breaking New Zealand's Amelia Kerr's record for both men's and women's cricket. Kerr set the record against Ireland in 2018 with 134 balls. In his 131-ball knock, Ishan Kishan hit 24 fours and 10 sixes while sharing a second-wicket partnership of 290 with Virat Kohli, the seventh-highest in men's ODI history.

RBI Monetary Policy 2022: RBI Repo Rate Hike By 35 Bps To 6.25%:-

The Reserve Bank of India recently increased the repo rate by 35 basis points to 6.25 percent. The RBI Monetary Policy Committee (MPC) voted to raise interest rates in order to bring elevated inflation back to its target of 4%, according to governor Shaktikanta Das. Das stated that the MPC had maintained its current fiscal year inflation forecast of 6.7%. The

MPC has kept its inflation forecast for the first quarter of the next fiscal year at 5%, while the price gauge is expected to be 5.4% in the second quarter, according to Das.


DAILY UPDATE 3:AWARDS

The Hampi Kannada University's Nadoja Award was given to Director Dr C N Manjunath of Sri Jayadeva Institute of Cardiovascular Sciences and Research, Bengaluru, and writers Krishnappa G and S Shadakshari. During the Nudihabba (convocation), Governor Thaawar Chand Gehlot presented the Award . SaikhomMirabaiChanu Wins Silver At Weightlifting World Championship In Colombia:-

MirabaiChanu, an Olympic silver medalist, won silver at the 2022 World Weightlifting Championships in Colombia. She defeated China's Olympic champion, Hou Zhihua. MirabaiChanu lifted a total of 200kg (87kg snatch + 113kg clean and jerk) for her world championships medal despite suffering from wrist pain. Mirabai's second World Championships

medal, having previously won gold in 2017 with a lift of 194 kg. Meanwhile, Jiang Huihua of China won the gold medal with a combined weight of 206 kg.

India's Coal Production Increased By 11.66 % In November:-

In November of this year, India's total coal production increased by 11.66% to 75.87 Million Ton (MT) from 67.94 MT in November of last year. According to the Coal Ministry, 24 mines out of the top 37 mines in coal production have produced more than 100 per cent and production of five mines stood between 80 and 100 percent. During the period, Coal based power generation has also registered a growth of 16.28 per cent. It further stated that the power utilities dispatch has increased by 3.55 per cent to 62.34 MT during last month.

NSIC Signs MoU With Walmart:-

RBI Allows Blocking Of Funds For Multiple Auto-Debits In UPI:-

The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) expanded the capabilities of the Unified Payments Interface (UPI) by introducing a 'single-block-and-multiple-debits' functionality, which allows a customer to enable a payment mandate against a merchant by blocking funds in his/her bank account for specific purposes, which can be debited whenever necessary. This feature is expected to have a wide range of applications, including e-commerce transactions, secondary market investment, and the purchase of government securities through the RBI's Retail Direct scheme.



Time Magazine's 2022 Person Of The Year: Volodymyr Zelensky And "Spirit Of Ukraine":-

Time magazine named President Volodymyr Zelensky, as well as "the spirit of Ukraine," its 2022 person of the year for the country's resistance to Russia's invasion. Time editor in chief Edward Felsenthal called Zelensky's decision to remain in Kyiv and rally his country amid the ongoing war "fateful," adding that this year's decision was "the most clear-cut in memory." Since Russia's February 24 invasion, Zelensky has delivered daily speeches that have been watched by citizens and governments all over the world, not just Ukrainians.

Oxford Dictionary Chooses 'Goblin Mode' As Word Of Year 2022:-

In a year when COVID-19 lockdown restrictions were gradually relaxed, "goblin mode" appeared to be an apt representation of people's sentiments, who rejected the curated aesthetics of perfection on display across social media. The first Oxford word of the year chosen by public vote is a "slang term" that refers to "unapologetically self-indulgent, lazy, slovenly, or greedy behaviour, typically in a way that rejects social norms or expectations." "#IStandWith" received 8,639 votes, while "Metaverse" received 14,484 votes.

IPL Remains The Google India Most Searched Query In 2022:-

Google has published its "Year in Search 2022" report, which highlights the topics that sparked the most interest and were the most frequently searched on the website this year. According to the list, which is published annually for various countries, India's search trends have changed noticeably since last year. The Indian Premier League (IPL), the most searched sporting event in the country, topped all 2022 trending search results in India. IPL was followed by CoWIN, a government website portal that issues digital vaccine certificates.
