**DAILY UPDATE 2 :APPOINTMENT****Akshaya Moondra Appointed As CEO Of Vodafone Idea:-**

Vodafone Idea has appointed Akshaya Moondra as its chief executive officer (CEO) for a three-year term beginning August 19. The appointment follows the expiration of current CEO Ravinder Takkar's three-year term on August 18. Takkar, however, will remain a non-executive and non-independent director of the company after his term as MD & CEO

ends, the company said in a statement. Moondra has over thirty years of international experience and over 14 years of telecom experience in India.

### **China Launches “Wentian,” Second Of Its Three Space Station Modules:-**

A new scientific lab docked with China's under-construction space station, Tiangong, in a major milestone for the country's space programme, bringing it closer to competition. According to the China Manned Space Agency, the Wentian module docked with the Tiangong station's main Tianhe living module. Wentian, the second of three modules to its permanent space station, was launched from the Wenchang Space Launch Center on the southern island of Hainan onboard China's most powerful rocket, the Long March 5B. After nearly 13 hours of travel after launch, the spacecraft arrived at its destination.




### **Center Modifies Flag Code Of India 2002 To Permit Tricolour To Be Displayed Constantly:-**

If the national flag is hoisted in the open and by a member of the public, it can now stay up all night. The Ministry of Home Affairs amended the Flag Code of India 2002 to allow the national flag to be flown even at night, as the central government launches the Har Ghar Tiranga campaign on August 13. Previously, the flag could only be flown between

sunrise and sunset. The ministry said that clause XI of paragraph 2.2 of the Flag Code was replaced by the following clause: "where the flag is displayed in the open or displayed on the house of a member of the public, it may be flown day and night".

### BCCI Introduced A New A+ Category For Umpires:-

The Board of Control for Cricket in India (BCCI) has created a new A+ category for its umpires, which includes Nitin Menon and ten other officials. Other international umpires in the A+ category include Anil Chaudhary, Madangopal

Jayaraman, Virender Kumar Sharma, and K N Ananthapadmabhanan. The A+ category also includes Rohan Pandit, Nikhil Patwardhan, Sadashiv Iyer, Ulhas Gandhe, and Navdeep Singh Sidhu. For a first-class game, umpires in the A+ and A categories are paid Rs 40,000 per day, while umpires in the B and C categories are paid Rs 30,000 per day.

### **Madhya Pradesh's Burhanpur became the first Certified 'Har Ghar Jal' district in the Country:-**

Burhanpur, Madhya Pradesh, also known as the 'Darwaza of Dakhin,' became the country's first certified 'Har Ghar Jal' district. Burhanpur is the only district in the country where people from each of the 254 villages have declared their villages to be 'Har Ghar Jal' through a Gram Sabha resolution. As a result, it certifies that all residents of the villages have access to safe drinking water via taps. Only 37,241 rural households (36.54 percent) out of a total of 1,01,905 households in Burhanpur had potable drinking water through tap connections when the Jal Jeevan Mission was launched on August 15, 2019.

### **Canara Bank Launched Its Mobile App Named "Canara ai1":-**

Canara Bank has launched its mobile banking app, Canara ai1. The banking app would be a one-stop shop with over 250 features to meet its customers' banking needs. Its goal is to eliminate the need for multiple mobile apps to work in silos to provide different services. The app is available in 11 languages, allowing it to reach out to people from all walks of life

in their preferred language. The app supports a variety of social security schemes, such as public provident fund accounts, sukanyasamruddhi accounts, senior citizens' savings accounts, Kisan Vikas Patra accounts, and others.

### **Rajnath Singh Announces The Formation Of Combined Tri-Service Theatre Commands:-**

Defence Minister Rajnath Singh announced the formation of tri-service joint theatre commands to improve armed forces coordination. The defence minister also stated that India is rapidly transitioning from the world's largest importer of defence equipment to an exporter. Referring to the defence production, Singh said, "India was the world's largest importer (of defence products). Today, India is not the world's largest importer but is among the top 25 nations engaged in defence exports," he pointed out.
