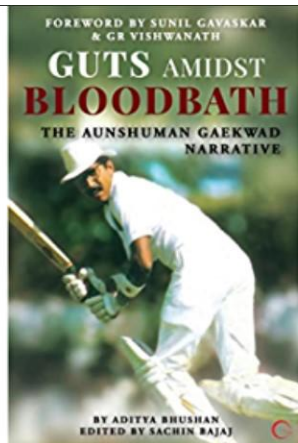

RBI Approves Rs 87,416 Crore Surplus Transfer To Government For FY23:-

The Reserve Bank of India's board has approved the transfer of Rs 87,416 crore to the Central Government as a surplus. The central bank also agreed to increase the contingency risk buffer from 5.5% to 6%, according to a press release. The RBI transferred Rs 30,307 crore to the government in FY22. The board, led by Shaktikanta Das, addressed the Reserve Bank's operations from April 2022 to March 2023 and approved the Reserve Bank's Annual Report and accounts for the fiscal year 2022-23.

IDBI, BOB, And SBI Capital Chosen To Manage IREDA IPO For Renewable Energy Development:-

The government has hired IDBI Capital, BOB Capital, and SBI Capital to oversee the Indian Renewable Energy Development Agency's (IREDA) initial public offering (IPO). IDBI Capital is the transaction's principal banker. Separately, Saraf and Partners has been designated as the IPO's legal counsel. The IPO, which is scheduled in FY24, will most likely consist of the government selling a 10% stake and the renewable energy project financier issuing 15% new equity to fund its business expansion.

Defence Production In India Surpasses ₹ 1 Lakh Crore Mark On The Back Of Crucial Reforms:-

According to the Defence Ministry, the value of defence manufacturing in Fiscal Year 2022-23 has surpassed 1 lakh crore for the first time. "The value currently stands ₹ 1,06,800 crore and it will go further up once the data is received from the remaining private defence industries," a Defence Ministry statement said. "The current value of defence production in FY 2022-23 is a rise of more than 12% over FY 2021-22, when the figure was ₹ 95,000 crore. Under the Make in India initiative, there has been a strong emphasis on growing local defence manufacturing, encouraging private sector participation, and increasing exports.

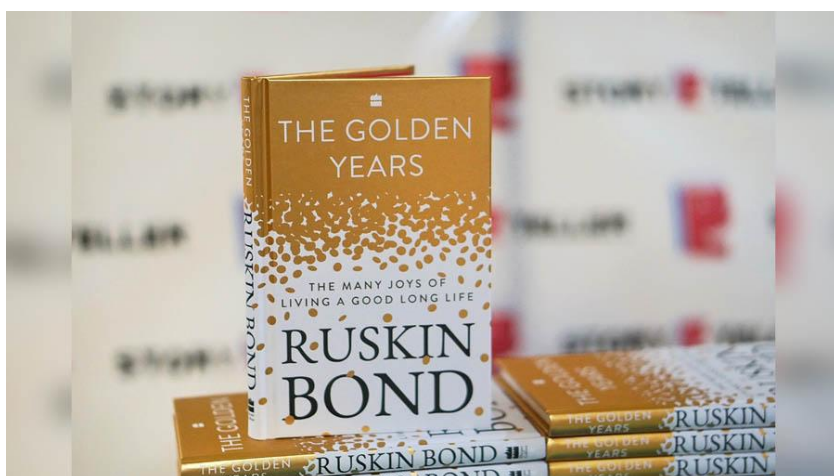

Vaghsheer, Indian Navy's Final Kalvari Class Submarine, Begins Sea Trials:-

Vaghsheer, the Indian Navy's sixth and final Kalvari class submarine, has begun sea trials and is anticipated to be commissioned early next year. The submarine's commissioning under Project-75 is expected to boost the Navy's combat capability at a time when China is strengthening its presence in the Indian Ocean region. Following the completion of sea testing, Vaghsheer will be delivered to the Indian Navy in early 2024. The submarine was launched in April of last year at the Mazagon Dock Shipbuilders Limited (MDL) KanhojiAngre Wet Basin.

Credit Suisse Group AG And UBS Group AG's Proposed Merger Approved By CCI:-

The proposed merger of Credit Suisse Group AG and UBS Group AG has been approved by the Competition Commission of India (CCI). The UBS Group AG (UBS) is a multinational investment bank and financial services firm headquartered in Switzerland that operates globally. According to CCI, the transaction involves UBS' proposed acquisition of Credit Suisse through an absorption merger, with UBS being the surviving legal company. Following the purchase, all of Credit Suisse's assets, obligations, and contracts will be transferred to UBS.

'75/25' Initiative For People With Hypertension, Diabetes Launched:-

The Union Health Ministry announced the "75/25" plan, in which 75 million people will be screened for hypertension and diabetes. The Shashakt Portal will bring healthcare services closer to the community by training 40,000 primary healthcare medical officers on the standard treatment procedure for NCDs. The screening would take place at public health centres (PHCs). The announcement was made by the Health Ministry at a G20 co-branded event with the World Health Organisation (WHO). The event titled "Accelerating the Prevention and Management of Hypertension and Diabetes".
