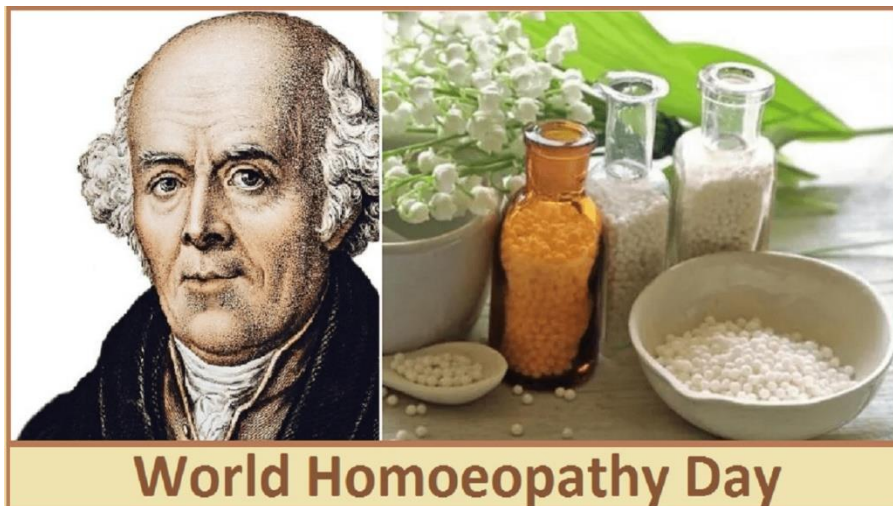

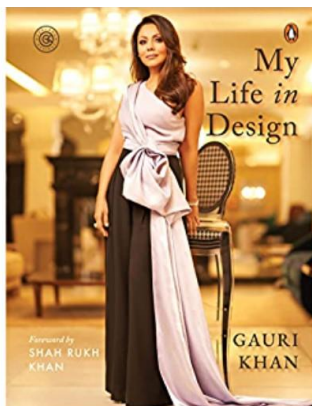
### **DAILY UPDATE 1 :IMPORTANT DAY**



#### **World Homeopathy Day :10 April:-**

Every year on April 10, World Homeopathy Day is observed to honour homeopathy and its contributions to the world of medicine. The day commemorates the birthday of German physician Dr Christian Friedrich Samuel Hahnemann, the founder of homeopathy. Hahnemann, who was born in Paris on April 10, 1755, was a renowned scientist, scholar, and linguist. He discovered a method of healing using homeopathy. He passed away on July 2, 1843. The theme for World Homeopathy Day 2023 is 'One Health, One Family'.

Ramani Ammal, a popular Tamil folk singer, died on April 4 in Chennai of a massive heart attack at the age of 69. She rose to prominence in the Tamil entertainment industry after appearing on Zee TV's reality show 'Sa Re Ga Ma Pa

Seniors' in 2017. Despite making her film debut as a singer in the 2004 romantic film 'Kadhal,' followed by a few other films such as 'Kathayavaran' (2008), 'Thenavattu' (2008), and 'Haridas' (2013), Ammal did not receive many opportunities and continued her life as a domestic servant.

Dhanya Rajendran, co-founder and editor of news website The News Minute, has received the Chameli Devi Jain Award for Outstanding Woman Mediaperson 2022. ### Hero Motocorp Board Appoints Niranjana Gupta As CEO:-

Niranjana Gupta has been named CEO of Hero Motocorp, a manufacturer of motorcycles and scooters. Gupta's appointment will be effective on May 1, 2023. He has been promoted from the position of Chief Financial Officer (CFO) and Head-Strategy and M&A. According to an exchange filing, Niranjana has played a key role in Hero Motocorp's

partnerships with global brands such as Harley Davidson and Zero Motorcycles. In addition, Gupta sits on the boards of Ather Energy, HMCL Colombia, and HMC MM Auto Private Limited.

### UAE President Appoints Sheikh Mansour As Vice-President:-

The President of the United Arab Emirates (UAE), Sheikh Mohamed bin Zayed Al Nahyan, has appointed his brother, Sheikh Mansour bin Zayed Al Nahyan, as Vice President of the country, according to the official Emirates News Agency. The UAE Federal Supreme Council approved the appointment. Sheikh Mansour has held the positions of Deputy Prime Minister of the UAE and Minister of the Presidential Court. He has extensive public service experience and has held a number of important positions since 2004.

## DAILY UPDATE 10 :SPORTS



### Runner Lashinda Demus Awarded Olympic Gold Medal Over A Decade Later:-

Lashinda Demus, an American runner, became an Olympic champion at the age of 40, more than a decade after the 2012 London Games. The International Olympic Committee formally reallocated Demus' gold medal in the 400-meter hurdles due to Natalya Antyukh's disqualification in the aftermath of the Russian doping scandal. On the London track on Aug. 8, 2012, Demus finished 0.07 seconds behind Antyukh, who was implicated last year in the second doping case of her career.
