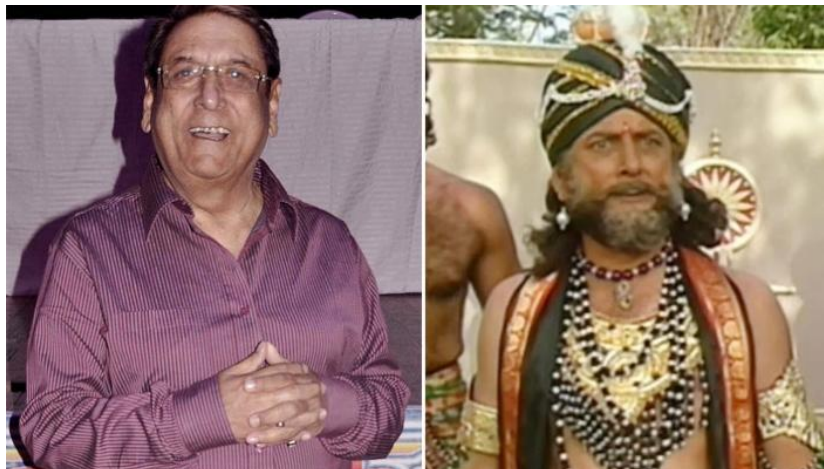

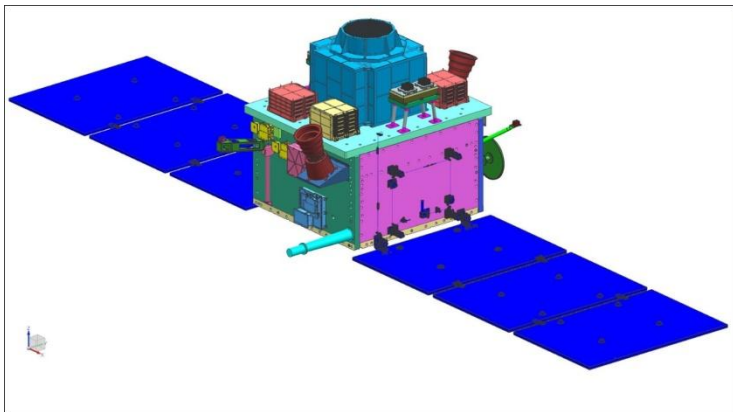


### Department Of Animal Husbandry And Fisheries, Chandigarh Awarded Skoch SILVER Award 2023:-

The agency of Animal Husbandry and Fisheries in Chandigarh received the Skoch SILVER Award 2023 for e-Governance for computerising medical data for livestock treated by the agency. This is the country's first project of its kind. More specifically, Secretary Animal Husbandry and Fisheries Vinod P Kavle stated that this web-based application software caters to the Animal Husbandry Department's five Government Veterinary Hospitals and nine Veterinary Sub-centres in Chandigarh.

#### XPoSat, India's First Polarimetry Mission:-

The Indian Space Research Organisation is working with the Raman Research agency (RRI), Bengaluru, an autonomous research agency, to create the X-Ray Polarimeter Satellite (XPoSat), which is set to launch later this year. It is advertised as India's first and only the world's second polarimetry mission, with the goal of studying the varied dynamics of intense astronomical X-ray sources in harsh settings. NASA's Imaging X-ray Polarimetry Explorer (IXPE), which was launched in 2021, is another such big mission.

#### Indian Bank Joins ICCL As Clearing And Settlement Bank:-

Indian Bank has entered into an agreement with Indian Clearing Corporation Ltd. (ICCL) as its Clearing and Settlement Bank. According to a release, Indian Bank will now provide banking services to members of the BSE, Mumbai for clearing and settlement operations. Clearing members can now open settlement accounts with the bank for the equities derivatives segment to settle funds. Furthermore, with its dedicated branch in Fort, Mumbai, Indian Bank launched the e-TDR solution for online transmission of FDR and margin with ICCL on behalf of clearing members.

#### **India's GDP Growth Projected At 7.1% In FY23: SBI EcowrapReport:-**

According to the most recent SBI Ecowrap study, the country's GDP (gross domestic product) is predicted to expand at a 7.1% annual rate in FY23. This is consistent with the National Statistical Office's (NSO) second advance projections announced in February, which forecast the country's real GDP at 7% in FY23. According to the report, global activity has remained resilient, aided by strong service sector expansion. Global headline inflation is expected to reduce from 8.7% in 2022 to 7.0% in 2023 as commodity prices fall, but underlying (core) inflation is expected to fall more slowly.

#### **ISRO's GSLV-F12 Successfully Places Navigation Satellite NVS-01:-**

The Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) has successfully launched the NVS-01 navigation satellite into Geosynchronous Transfer Orbit, weighing approximately 2232 kg. Speaking from the control room, ISRO Chairman S. Somanath praised the mission team and stated that GSLV had precisely positioned the satellite in orbit. According to ISRO, the GSLV-F12 is India's 15th GSLV flight and the 9th flight with an indigenous cyro stage. This is the GSLV's sixth operational flight using an indigenous cryogenic stage.

Telangana State has achieved 100 percent household coverage of banking services since the inception of the Prime Minister Jan Dhan Yojana (PMJDY), expanding them to all sectors of the population. According to the Social Security Administration survey, the state has achieved 100 percent coverage, and the benefits of 135 welfare schemes and programmes administered by 20 departments are deposited to the recipients' zero-balance bank accounts. By the middle of May, Telangana had over 1 crore 11 lakh Jan Dhan bank account holders.

#### **Income Proof Now Mandatory For Rs 10 Lakh Investments In Small Savings Schemes:-**

The government has now made verification of source of funds obligatory for those investing more than Rs 10 lakh in post office schemes such as Public Provident Fund (PPF), National Savings Certificate (NSC), Kisan Vikas Patra (KVP), and others. It has also made all investments in post office programmes subject to stronger KYC/PMLA compliance regulations in order to avoid misuse for terrorist financing/money laundering. The Department of Posts has asked post office employees to obtain proof of income from certain types of small savings programme investors.

#### Khelo India University Games-2022 concludes in Varanasi:-

Third khelo India University games recently concluded. The closing ceremony was conducted on the campus of IIT BHU in Varanasi. Panjab University reclaims the winners' title, while Guru Nanak Dev University falls short despite a Fencing sweep on the final day. After a one-year absence, Punjab University, Chandigarh, reclaimed their overall champion title at the Khelo India University Games. Punjab University, Chandigarh won 69 medals in total, including 26 gold, 17 silver, and 26 bronze medals.
