


## 11 JULY, 2022 DAILY UPDATE 1 :SPORTS



### Rafael Nadal won the opening match at Wimbledon:-

Rafael Nadal conquered his fear in the opening match at Wimbledon. After losing to Roger Federer in the 2019 Wimbledon semifinals, Rafael Nadal returned to action. Rafael Nadal defeated Argentina's Francisco Cerundolo in four sets on Tuesday in his opening round of the competition for his third Wimbledon victory. Rafael Nadal, a two-time winner, initially appeared to be in charge of the match and aggressively handled the first two sets. Rafael Nadal has been pulled out of the Wimbledon 2022 semi-finals due to an abdominal injury.

### Sri Lankan President Rajapaksa back in action:-

After the fuel-starved nation received 3,700 metric tonnes of LP gas, the embattled President Gotabaya Rajapaksa, whose whereabouts are still unknown because the protesters overran both his office and the official residence, ordered officials to ensure the efficient distribution of cooking gas, according to his office's statement on July 10. People have been obstructing roads all around the nation in recent months in an effort to pressure the government to address the problem of severe gas shortages.


## DAILY UPDATE 6 : NATIONAL



### MoU to End TB:-

A Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) was signed between the Ministry of Panchayati Raj (MoPR) and the Central TB Division, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, in order to eradicate tuberculosis (TB) in India (MoH&FW). To eradicate TB in India by 2025, the MoU would create interministerial collaborations and strategic alliances. The National Tuberculosis Elimination Program (NTEP) Joint Secretary, Dr. P. Ashok Babu, and the MoPR's Economic Adviser, Dr. Bijaya Kumar Behera, both signed the Memorandum of Understanding (MoU).

## DAILY UPDATE 7 : MISCELLANEOUS



### Reliance Jio VS Bharti Airtel:-

According to industry executives and analysts, the Adani Group's entry into the 5G spectrum race and its plans to provide private captive network solutions could lead to increased competition for India's top telcos, who could see a decline in their potential revenue from enterprise services as well as from airwaves leasing. Industry insiders anticipate that the Gautam Adani-led conglomerate, which is flush with cash, may engage in a bidding war for 5G airwaves in both the highly sought-after but pricey 3.3–3.67 GHz band and the less expensive 26 GHz band with Reliance Jio and Bharti Airtel.

## DAILY UPDATE 8 : NATIONAL



### Unemployment Rate India:-

The Centre for Monitoring Indian Economy (CMIE) has released data showing that India's unemployment rate increased from 7.12 percent in May 2022 to 7.8 percent in June 2022. The rise in the unemployment rate in rural areas was the primary cause of the increase. From 6.62 percent in May 2022 to 8.03 percent in June 2022, the rural unemployment rate rose. From 8.21% in May 2022, the urban unemployment rate dropped to 7.30% in June 2022. The highest unemployment rate in June 2022 are Haryana (30.6 per cent) followed by Rajasthan (29.8 per cent).

## DAILY UPDATE 9 :INTERNATIONAL



### **Indo-United States, against Drug Trade:-**

An Indo-US Counter-Narcotics Working Group (CNWG) meeting was conducted on July 8, 2022, to examine drug law enforcement and the rise in heroin seizures from Afghanistan. Director-general of the Narcotics Control Bureau (NCB), SN Pradhan, served as the delegation's leader. The Amended Letter of Agreement on enhancing collaboration and sharing intelligence was signed by Tarun Bajaj, the Indian revenue secretary, and Patricia Lacina, the US Charge d'Affaires.

### **Augmented reality in Mumbai :-**

The first Augmented Reality (AR) experience in a train station in India is now available at Mumbai's Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj Terminus (CSMT). With the use of this technology, station visitors will be able to access a real-time, digital timetable that includes railroad information and scrolls on a dedicated screen. In addition to being able to virtually travel anywhere in the world, passengers of the aircraft will be able to interact with animals, see magic tricks, and experience snowfall thanks to Augmented Reality (AR) magic mirrors.
