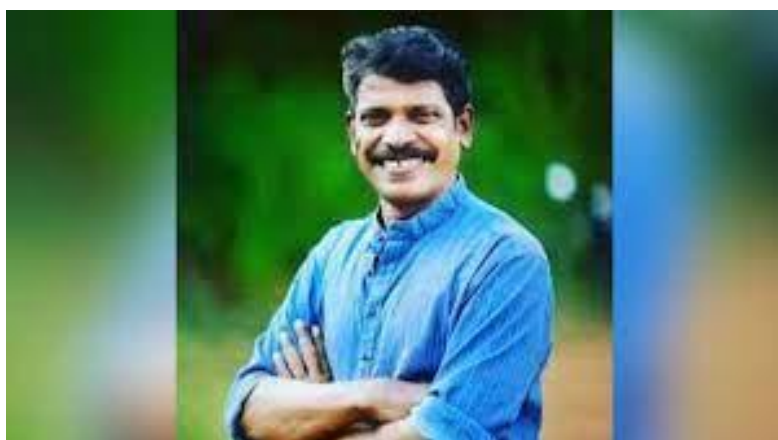
DAILY UPDATE 1 :SUMMITS AND CONFERENCES



G20 Health Working Group Meeting Held In Hyderabad:-

The G20 Health Working Group (HWG) had its third meeting in Hyderabad from June 4 to 6. The third HWG meeting included both a main event and a side session focused on collaboration on research and development in Medical Counter Measures (MCMs). In addition to India, participants from 19 G20 member countries, 10 invited countries, and 22 international organisations attended the third HWG meeting. The health priorities were outlined and debated in depth at the HWG sessions in Thiruvananthapuram and Goa in January and April of this year, respectively.

'Fire prevention: life safety and fire protection' Book to prevent fire disasters launched:-

Dilip Patel, former principal of M S University's Polytechnic College, has published a book titled 'Fire prevention: life safety and fire protection,' which includes basic recommendations on how to protect yourself from fire disasters. "This book is based on the Gujarat Comprehensive Development Control Regulations, the Gujarat Fire Act 2013 which was amended in 2021 and the National Building Code which has now become an integral part of the Gujarat Fire Act," said Patel, who was appointed as fire safety officer by the Gujarat government in 2021.

Govt Approves Digital Communication Framework Between Banks And CEIB:-

The Centre has approved a rapid digital reporting and communication mechanism to address loan defaults of more than Rs 50 crore. According to reports, the Union government has put in place a digital mechanism under which the Central Economic Intelligence Bureau (CEIB) will send a report digitally regarding borrowers to PSU banks for a loan amount of Rs 50 crore or higher at the pre-approval stage within 15 days of request, while ending the paper-based communication system. The new system was approved by the Union Finance Minister after extensive engagement with all stakeholders.

Mukesh Ambani Joins COP28 Advisory Committee To Address Climate Crisis:-

Mukesh Ambani, Chairman and Managing Director of Reliance Industries, has been nominated to the Advisory Committee to the President of the 28th Conference of the Parties (COP28) to the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC). Apart from Sunita Narain, Director General of the Centre for Science and Environment, Mukesh Ambani is the only Indian on the Advisory Committee to the President of COP28. The UAE Advisory Committee for COP28 brings together climate expertise from thought leaders from six continents.

RBI Imposes Rs 84.50 Lakh Penalty On Central Bank Of India For Non-Compliance With Fraud Reporting Norms:-

The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) announced a penalty of Rs 84.50 lakh against the Central Bank of India (the bank) for failing to comply with certain requirements of regulations relating to fraud classification and reporting. The Reserve Bank conducted a required inspection to undertake a supervisory examination of the bank's financial status as of March 31, 2021. According to the reports, the public sector lender neglected to notify some accounts as fraudulent to the RBI within seven days following the Joint Lenders' Forum (JLF) resolution to designate the accounts fraudulent.

CAG Girish Chandra Murmu Re-Elected External Auditor Of WHO For 4 Year Term:-

Girish Chandra Murmu, India's Comptroller and Auditor General (CAG), has been re-elected as the World Health Organization's (WHO) external auditor for a four-year term from 2024 to 2027. He has held the job for four years, from 2019 to 2023. The office of the Comptroller and Auditor General (CAG) said in a statement that the election took place at the 76th World Health Assembly in Geneva, where the CAG of India was re-elected in the first round of voting with 114 out of 156 votes.

Health Index Report Of Covid Year: Kerala And Tamil Nadu Top Performers:-

In NITI Aayog's annual 'Health Index' for the Covid-19 pandemic year of 2020-21, Kerala, Tamil Nadu, and Telangana emerged as the top-performing states among the 'big states', Tripura did well in the smaller states category, and Delhi ranked last among the Union Territories. The NITI Aayog Health Index, created in 2017, evaluates the performance of states and union territories using 24 health performance metrics. The comprehensive health index was developed in collaboration with the Union Health Ministry and the World Bank.

Sachin Tendulkar Now 'Smile Ambassador' For Maharashtra Govt:-

Sachin Tendulkar has been chosen the 'Smile Ambassador' for Maharashtra's Swachh Mukh Abhiyan, an oral hygiene initiative. Tendulkar signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with Maharashtra Chief Minister Eknath Shinde and Deputy Chief Minister Devendra Fadnavis. For the next five years, the batting legend will serve as the campaign's brand ambassador. The Indian Dental Association's Swachh Mukh Abhiyaan is a countrywide programme to enhance oral health and hygiene to educate people about its relevance.

Angshumali Rastogi Appointed As India's Representative To Global Civil Aviation Org:-

According to a Personnel Ministry directive, senior bureaucrat Angshumali Rastogi has been named India's representative to the International Civil Aviation Organisation (ICAO) council in Montreal, Canada. Rastogi, a 1995 batch officer of the Indian Railway Service of Mechanical Engineers (IRSME), has been appointed for three years in place of Shefali Juneja. Hemang Jani, Secretary of the Capacity Building Commission, has been appointed for three years as Senior Adviser to the Executive Director of the World Bank in Washington, DC.
