International Day of the Girl Child :11 October:-

The United Nations declared International Day of the Girl Child in order to raise awareness of issues affecting young girls around the world. Gender equality and women's empowerment, according to the United Nations, are essential components. Every year on October 11, the International Day of the Girl is observed. On December 19, 2011, the United Nations General Assembly passed a resolution designating October 11 as International Day of the Girl Child. Sujoy Lal Thaosen, Anish Dayal Singh Named As New DGs Of CRPF, ITBP:-

Sujoy Lal Thaosen and Anish Dayal Singh, both senior Indian Police Service (IPS) officers, have been appointed as the new directors general of the CRPF and ITBP, respectively. Thaosen, a Madhya Pradesh cadre officer from 1988, is currently the director general (DG) of the border guarding force Sashastra Seema Bal (SSB) and the additional charge of

the Indo-Tibetan Border Police. The post of Central Reserve Police Force (CRPF) DG recently became vacant after IPS officer Kuldiep Singh (1986-batch West Bengal cadre) retired.

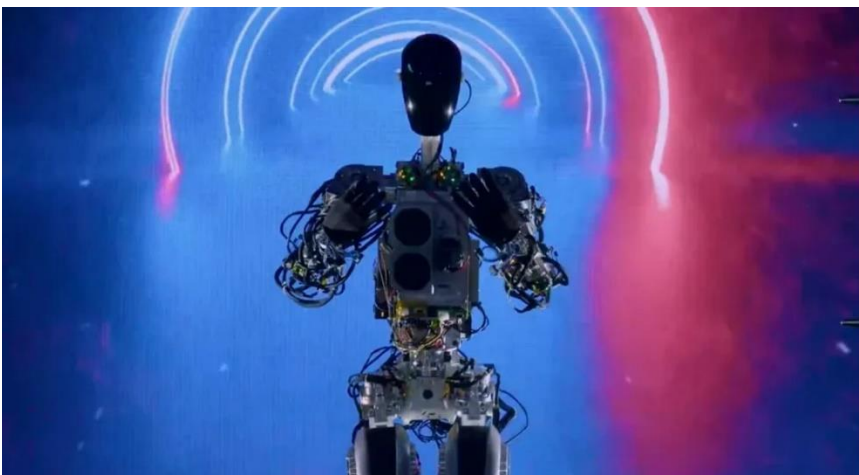

Former UP CM Mulayam Singh Yadav Passes Away:-

Mulayam Singh Yadav, the founder of the Samajwadi Party, died on October 10 while receiving treatment at the Medanta hospital in Gurugram. He was 82. For the past few weeks, the SP patriarch's condition had been "quite critical," and he was on life-saving drugs. The Samajwadi Party (SP) founder and three-time Uttar Pradesh chief minister, Mulayam Singh Yadav, rose in UP politics in a period of intense social and political ferment after the 1970s. He took oath as UP's 15th CM in 1989, which marked the year when the Congress was voted out, failing to return to power in the state ever since.

Optimus Robot's Prototype Unveiled By Elon Musk, CEO Of Tesla:-

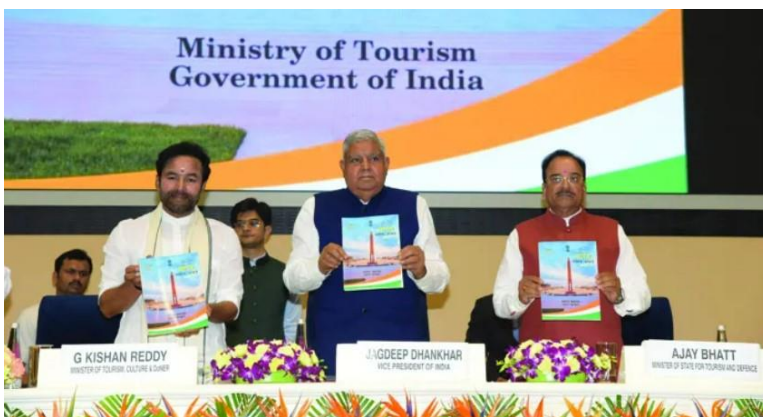
Elon Musk, CEO of Tesla, debuted his much-touted humanoid robot "Optimus" at the electric vehicle manufacturer's "AI Day" event. Musk announced Tesla's plan for humanoid robots at its AI day in August last year, and this year's event has been pushed back from August to allow the company's robot prototype to be tested, with plans to begin production possibly next year. Musk has stated that Tesla will achieve full self-driving capability this year and will mass-produce a robotaxi without a steering wheel or pedal by 2024.

**Uddhav camp gets 'mashaal' as poll symbol:-**

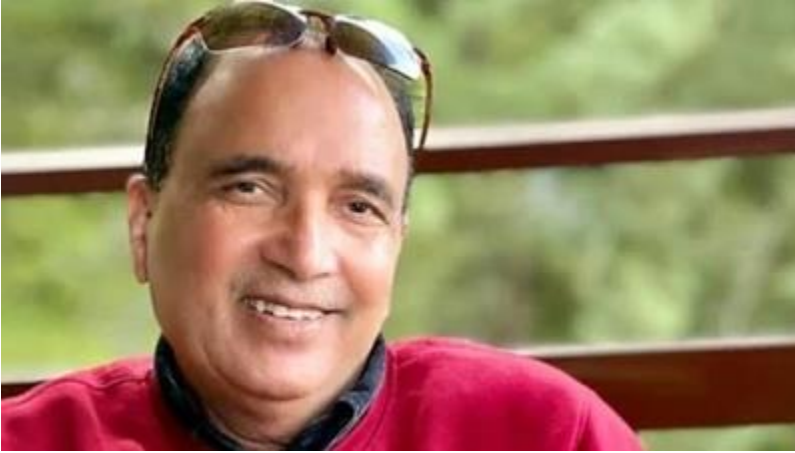
On 10 October, the Election Commission (EC) assigned the 'mashaal (flaming torch)' as the Shiv Sena's poll symbol to the Uddhav Thackeray-led faction. The poll panel rejected the Uddhav camp's choice of 'trishul,' citing its religious connotation, and 'rising sun,' citing its association with the DMK. Shiv Sena is the name given to the Thackeray faction (UddhavBalasaheb Thackeray). The EC had barred both Shiv Sena factions from using the party name and its 'bow and arrow' election symbol in the November 3 Andheri East assembly bypolls on October 8.

**Tamil Nadu And Maharashtra Topped Destinations For Foreign Tourists 2021:-**

According to a report released by the Union Tourism Ministry, Maharashtra and Tamil Nadu had the highest number of foreign tourist visits in 2021, with 1.26 million and 1.23 million, respectively. Vice President Jagdeep Dhankhar presented the report at Vigyan Bhawan in New Delhi on World Tourism Day. According to the report, the most popular centrally protected ticketed monument for domestic visitors in the previous year was Tamil Nadu's Group of Monuments at Mamallapuram. The Taj Mahal in Agra was also among the top ten on the list.

Writer-Academic Madhav Hada To Be Awarded 32nd Bihari Puraskar:-

The KK Birla Foundation has announced that writer Dr. Madhav Hada will receive the 32nd Bihari Puraskar for his 2015 literary criticism book 'Pachrang Chola PaharSakhi Ri.' The Bihari Puraskar was established in 1991 as one of three literary awards established by the foundation. The award, named after the famous Hindi poet Bihari, is given every year for an outstanding work published in Hindi or Rajasthani by a Rajasthani author in the previous ten years. A selection committee led by chairman Hemant Shesh selects the recipient.

Nobel Prize 2022: Svante Pääbo Awarded Nobel Prize In Medicine:-

Svante Pääbo was awarded the Nobel Prize in physiology or medicine in 2022 for his work on the genomes of extinct hominins and human evolution. The first of the 2021 Nobel Prizes kicked off the week of announcements of the most coveted award. Pääbo sequenced the genome of the Neanderthal, an extinct ancestor of modern humans. He also made the sensational discovery of Denisova, a previously unknown hominin. Svante Pääbo is Director, Max Planck Institute for Evolutionary Anthropology.

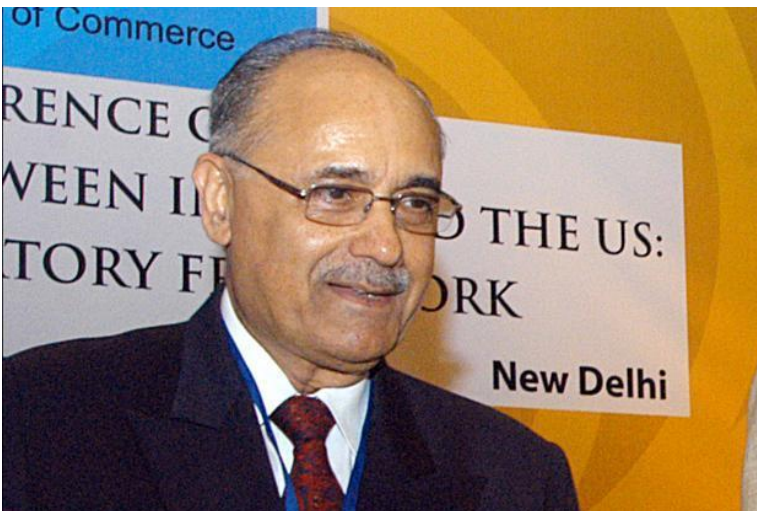

Indore Gets India's Cleanest City Tag: Swachh Survekshan Awards:-

Indore has been named the cleanest city in India for the sixth year in a row, with Surat and Navi Mumbai taking the next two spots. Madhya Pradesh was named the "best-performing state" in the central government's annual cleanliness survey. While Indore and Surat retained their first and second places in the country, respectively, Vijayawada fell to third place to Navi Mumbai. Madhya Pradesh is followed in the list of best performing states by Chhattisgarh and Maharashtra.
