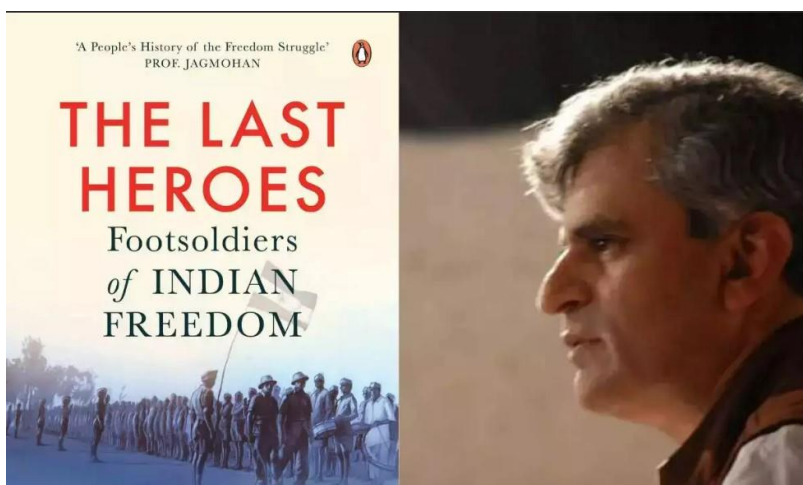
DAILY UPDATE 1 :IMPORTANT DAY



World Arthritis Day: 12 October :-

Every year on October 12, World Arthritis Day (WAD) is observed to raise awareness about the existence and impact of rheumatic diseases. On this day, arthritis campaigns are launched, and awareness is raised about timely diagnosis and management strategies. Arthritis affects a large portion of the world's population, impairing their quality of life and participation in society. An estimated one hundred million people are undiagnosed and coping with symptoms that are frequently overlooked and misdiagnosed. The theme for this year is "It's in your hands, take action."

Veteran actor Arun Bali passes away at 79 in Mumbai:-

Arun Bali, a veteran actor known for his roles in films such as 3 Idiots, Kedarnath, Panipat, and many others, died in Mumbai. He was 79. Bali made his acting debut as superstar Shah Rukh Khan's uncle in noted filmmaker Lekh Tandon's TV show 'Doosra Keval.' Some of his well-known films include 'Saugandh', 'Raju Ban Gaya Gentleman', 'Khalnayak', 'Satya', 'Hey Ram', 'Lage Raho Munna Bhai', '3 Idiots', 'Ready', 'Barfi', 'Manmarziyaan', 'Kedarnath', 'Samrat Prithviraj', and 'Laal Singh Chaddha'.

Indian Javelin Thrower Shivpal Singh Suspended Till 2025 For Doping:-

Shivpal Singh, an Indian javelin thrower, has been barred from competing until October 2025 due to a doping violation. According to reports, he later tested positive for the prohibited substance methandienone, a performance-enhancing steroid. As a result, Shivpal Singh was suspended for four years by the National Anti-Doping Agency (NADA). The ban takes effect on October 21, 2021, which means the 27-year-old will be out of commission until October 20, 2025. Shivpal Singh is the fifth prominent Indian athlete to be caught doping this year.

Light Combat Helicopter (LCH) Introduced In IAF Base At Jodhpur:-

At a ceremony held at Air Force Station Jodhpur in Rajasthan, Defence Minister Rajnath Singh formally inducted the indigenously developed Light Combat Helicopters (LCH) into the Indian Air Force. The LCH would be assigned to the 143 Helicopter Unit. Prachanda is the name given to LCH. In his remarks at the ceremony, Mr. Singh stated that the induction of the LCH not only improves the Air Force's combat capability but also represents a significant step toward the goal of Atmanirbhar Bharat. Hindustan Aeronautics Ltd created the LCH (HAL).

Fit India Freedom Run 3.0 Launched By Anurag Singh Thakur And Kiren Rijju:-

On the occasion of Gandhi Jayanti, the Fit India Freedom Run 3.0 was launched at the Major Dhyan Chand National Stadium in New Delhi. The third edition of one of the largest nationwide movements launched by the Government of India during the peak of the Covid-19 pandemic in 2020 was jointly launched with a Fit India Plog Run by Union Ministers of Law and Justice, Shri Kiren Rijju, and Youth Affairs and Sports, Shri Anurag Singh Thakur. The third edition of the Fit India Freedom Run began on October 2 and will run through October 31.

Suzlon Energy Chairman Tulsi Tanti Passes Away:-

Tulsi Tanti, the founder chairman and managing director of Suzlon Energy, died of cardiac arrest, according to a press release. Tanti, 64, was a well-known expert in the field of renewable energy. Tanti, who founded Suzlon Energy in 1995, was at the forefront of India's wind revolution. He saw opportunity in the Indian renewable energy industry at a time when the global wind energy market was dominated by international players and characterised by costly and complicated technologies that were largely unviable for traditional businesses.

Indian Skipper Rohit Sharma Becomes 1st Indian Cricketer To Play 400 T20s:-

Rohit Sharma has reached another milestone in his T20 career, becoming the first Indian to play 400 T20s. The milestone

was reached by India's captain during the second T20I of the series against South Africa in Guwahati. The first Indian to hit a century in T20 cricket, Rohit had made his shortest format debut for Mumbai against Baroda in April 2007. He joined the national team a few months later and was a member of the MS Dhoni-led team that won the 2007 T20 World Cup. Rohit has 10544* runs in T20Is, making him the highest run-scorer in the format.

Telangana Government Launched 'Aasara' Pension For Poor:-

The Telangana government has introduced 'Aasara' pensions as part of its welfare measures and social safety net strategy, with the goal of ensuring a secure life for all the poor. D Sunil Kumar, Tahsildar of Asif Nagar Mandal, stated that 10,000 new Aasara pensions have been sanctioned under Asif Nagar Mandal jurisdiction. "Total pensioners in Asif Nagar Mandal are 35,000 and new pensions are 10,000 and previous old pensions existing are 25,000. Window pensions sanctioned by the Telangana government have been given to respected people," he said.

FIBA Women's Basketball World Cup: USA Beat China To Secure 11th World Title:-

The United States defeated China 83-61 in the finals of the Federation Internationale de Basketball (FIBA) Women's

Basketball World Cup 2022. The final game also featured one of the highest leads in basketball for a gold medal, with the Americans breaking the 20-point barrier. The crowd erupted as the United States defeated China to win the championship. With this victory, the United States won their fourth game in a row, and the team is overjoyed to have been named the most dominant team in history.
