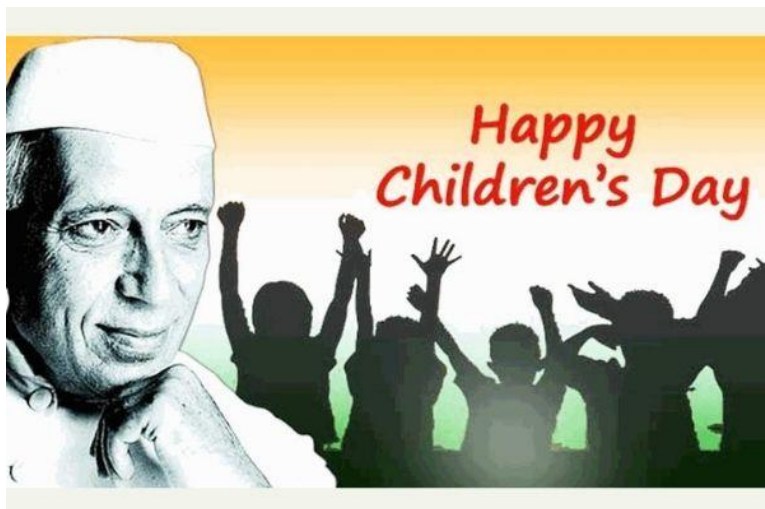

Children's Day :14th November:-

Children's Day is also observed in India as a tribute to India's first Prime Minister, Jawaharlal Nehru. Among children, he was also known as 'Chacha Nehru.' Jawaharlal Nehru advocated for a well-rounded education for children. Nehru also founded the Children's Film Society India to create indigenous cinema for children only. Following the death of Pandit Jawaharlal Nehru, the Indian Parliament passed a resolution designating November 14th, the birth anniversary of India's first Prime Minister, as Children's Day.

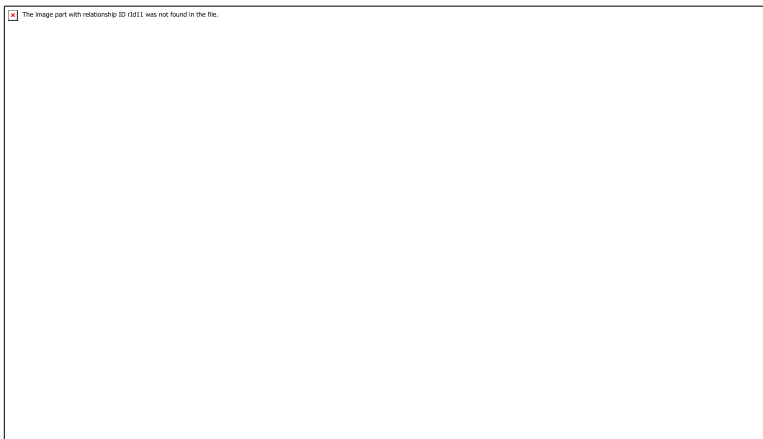


World Diabetes Day :14th November:-

Every year on November 14, the birthday of Sir Frederick Banting, who co-discovered insulin with Charles Best in 1922, World Diabetes Day is observed. The International Diabetes Federation (IDF) and the World Health Organization established World Diabetes Day (WDD) in 1991 in response to growing concerns about the escalating health threat

posed by diabetes. With the passage of the United Nations Resolution in 2006, World Diabetes Day became an official United Nations Day. The theme for World Diabetes Day 2021-23 is 'Access to Diabetes Care'.

Dr. Mohamed Irfaan Ali, President of Guyana, will be the chief guest at the 17th PravasiBharatiya Divas Convention. It will be held in Indore, Madhya Pradesh, from January 8th to 10th of next year. PravasiBharatiya Divas is celebrated every two years to strengthen the overseas Indian community's engagement with the Government of India and reconnect

them with their roots. The 9th of January was chosen as the date to commemorate this occasion because Mahatma Gandhi returned to India from South Africa on this day in 1915.

Madhya Pradesh: Ujjain To Get World's First Vedic Clock:-

A 'Vedic Clock' will be built at Jantar Mantar (Government Jiwaji Observatory) for Rs 1.62 crore. Higher education minister Mohan Yadav performed the Bhoomi Pujan of the clock's construction work. This clock will be set according to Vedic time calculation principles. Changes in sunrise and sunset times at various locations throughout the country and the world will also be synchronised. Mobile, LED, Smart TV, Tab, and Digital Watches will all see and display Vedic Clock applications.

Asian Hockey Federation CEO Tayyab Ikram Elected As New FIH President:-

Mohammad Tayyab Ikram of Macau has been elected as the new president of the International Hockey Federation (FIH), succeeding India's Narinder Batra as its full-time leader. In the 48th FIH Congress, held virtually, Ikram defeated Marc Coudron of Belgium 79-47. There were 126 valid votes cast out of 129 national associations. Ikram's term will last two years in order to finish the mandate of the previous chief, Batra, who resigned on July 18. Ikram was born in Pakistan and is now a Macau resident.

'Aadhaar Mitra,' a new chatbot launched by UIDAI:-

For a better resident experience, the Unique Identification Authority of India (UIDAI) has launched a new AI/ML-based chatbot called 'Aadhaar Mitra.' The new chatbot has improved features such as checking Aadhaar enrollment/update status, tracking Aadhaar PVC card status, and learning about enrollment centre locations. Residents can also use the bot to register and track their complaints. "The new Customer Relationship Management (CRM) solution has been designed with advanced features to enhance UIDAI service delivery to residents," said the Ministry of Electronics & IT.

ISRO plans to return to Mars, explore dark side of moon:-

Following missions to the moon and Mars, the Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) has set its sights on Venus and plans to explore the moon's dark side in collaboration with Japan. Anil Bhardwaj, Director of the Ahmedabad-based Physical Research Laboratory, said during a presentation on ISRO's future missions at the Akash Tattva conference that the space agency also planned to send a probe to Mars. Bhardwaj said it was in discussions with the Japanese Aerospace Exploration Agency (JAXA) about sending a lunar rover to explore the moon's permanent shadow region.

Virat Kohli And Nida Dar Named As ICC Player Of The Month Award For October 2022:-

Virat Kohli, India's star batter, has been named the ICC Men's Player of the Month for October 2022 after some outstanding performances in the T20 format. Veteran Pakistan all-rounder Nida Dar, on the other hand, has been named the ICC Women's Player of the Month for October 2022, following some outstanding all-rounder performances in the recently concluded tournament. Virat Kohli also receives his first Player of the Month award after scoring 205 runs and displaying the full range of his batting talent throughout the month of October.

Suryakumar Yadav Becomes 1st Indian Player To Score 1,000 T20 Runs:-

Suryakumar Yadav, a star Indian batter, recently became the first Indian player to score 1,000 T20 International runs in a calendar year. This feat was accomplished by the batter during his team's final Super 12 stage match against Zimbabwe in Melbourne. Suryakumar put the finishing touches on India's innings to ensure they finished on a high note. He scored 61 runs off 25 balls, including six fours and four sixes. Suryakumar has 1,026 runs scored at an average of 44.60 in 28 innings this season.
