Australia Crowned With ICC World Test Championship 2023:-

On June 11, Australia made history by becoming the first men's team in world cricket history to win an International Cricket Council (ICC) world title in all three formats. Australia accomplished the feat when they defeated India in the global Test Championship 2021-23 final at The Oval to become the new global champions of the game's longest format. Australia may have lost the Border-Gavaskar Trophy 2-1 in India earlier this year, but the world champions came out firing in the final at The Oval, defeating India by 209 runs.

Shalini Singh Becomes The First Female NCC Cadet To Complete Mountaineering Course:-

Shalini Singh made history by being the first female NCC cadet in India to complete a mountaineering course in Uttarakhand's Himalayan area. Shalini joined the 67 UP battalion after finishing the necessary basic mountaineering course. According to reports, she began her month-long course on April 26. What's more, Shalini was the only female cadet on the squad of 45 NCC cadets assembled for the expedition. To complete the course, the Senior Wing NCC cadet scaled 15,400 feet via snow-covered mountains in the Dring Valley.

Dubai Emerges As India's Top Choice For Foreign Direct Investment (FDI):-

Dubai, a popular tourism and shopping destination, is quickly becoming the top choice for Indian investment. In the calendar year 2022, Dubai is ranked first as a destination city for Indian foreign direct investment (FDI). According to the Dubai FDI Monitor, India is one of the top five source nations in terms of announced FDI projects and expected FDI capital in calendar year 2022. In 2022, India accounted for 12% of announced FDI projects in Dubai. Only the United States (20%) and the United Kingdom (13%) are ahead of India.

‘GOBARdhan’ Scheme: Govt Launches Unified Registration Portal For Biogas Projects:-

Gajendra Singh Shekhawat, the Union Minister for Jal Shakti, has launched a unified registration portal for 'GOBARdhan,' which will serve as a one-stop repository to assess investment and participation in the biogas or compressed biogas (CBG) sector at the pan-India level and streamline the process of setting up biogas plants in India. By enrolling in the unified registration site, any government, cooperative, or private entity operating or planning to operate a biogas, CBG, or Bio CNG plant in India can acquire a registration number.

WMO Gets Celeste Saulo As Its 1st Female Secretary-General:-

Argentina's Celeste Saulo has been named the World Meteorological Organization's (WMO) first female Secretary-General. Saulo was elected by a landslide majority at the United Nations Climate and Weather Conference in Geneva. Since 2014, Saulo has been the director of Argentina's National Meteorological Service. The World Meteorological Organisation (WMO) is critical in organising worldwide meteorological work. It measures essential elements of the atmosphere, land, and ocean using satellites and thousands of weather stations.

National Food Safety & Standards Training Centre Inaugurated By Dr. Mansukh Mandaviya:-

During the inauguration of the National Training Centre for the Food Safety and Standards Authority of India (FSSAI) in Ghaziabad, Uttar Pradesh, Union Minister for Health and Family Welfare Dr. Mansukh Mandaviya emphasised the importance of a healthy population in India's pursuit of becoming a developed nation. He stated that rigorous testing would be undertaken nationwide, and that those found guilty under the Food Safety and Standards Act of 2006 would face harsh penalties.

Gender-Inclusive Tourism Policy 'Aai' Gets Maharashtra Cabinet Approval:-

The Maharashtra cabinet has approved the 'Aai' (mother) tourism policy as part of the 'Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav'. The cabinet also approved female-run bike-taxi services in some tourist areas. According to an official, the Directorate of Tourism will establish a Women Tourism Policy Cell to oversee the execution of the Aai policy. A task force will also be formed under the presidency of the tourism minister to ensure that the strategy is effectively implemented, according to a statement from the Chief Minister's Office.

RBI Imposes Rs 2.20 Crore Penalty On Indian Overseas Bank For Rule Violations:-

The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) announced a Rs 2.20 crore fine against Indian Overseas Bank (IOB) for rule infractions. The penalty was imposed on IOB because it failed to make the minimum mandatory transfer of a sum equal to 25% of its disclosed profit for the fiscal year 2020-21 to its reserve fund, and there was a significant divergence between the non-performing assets (NPAs) as reported by it and as assessed by the inspection, according to the release. In this context, the RBI issued two notifications to the bank, directing it to show reason why a penalty should not be charged.
