

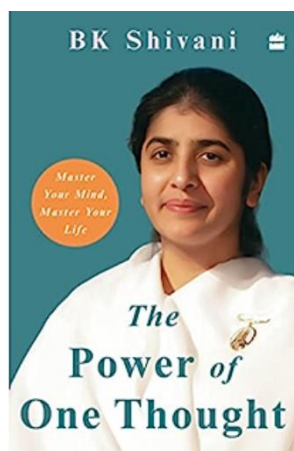

BoB Set To Reduce NSE Shareholding For At Least ₹ 661 Crore

The government-owned Bank of Baroda (BoB) has revealed its plan to sell a portion of its stake in the National Stock Exchange of India (NSE). The bank has filed a filing in which it invites potential bidders to submit bids for its stake in the exchange. The proposed auction establishes a minimum share price of Rs 3,150, valuing the NSE at Rs 156,000 crore. This will amount to a total transaction value of Rs 661.5 crore. Partnership firms, on the other hand, are ineligible to engage in the bidding process.

The World Bank anticipates India's growth to decline further to 6.3% in fiscal year FY 2023/24 (April to March). This represents a 0.3 percentage point decrease from the prior forecast of 6.6%. The fundamental reason for the slowdown, according to the international financial institution, is limited private consumption due to excessive inflation. The World Bank said in its Global Economic Prospects report that the downturn is due to private consumption being restrained by high inflation and rising borrowing costs, while government consumption is hurt by fiscal restraint.

DAILY UPDATE 8 : BANKING**Bank Of Baroda Introduces UPI Cash Withdrawal Facility At ATMs:-**

According to reports, Bank of Baroda (BoB) has unveiled a new way to withdraw cash using the Unified Payments Interface (UPI) in all of its ATMs. The action is in accordance with the Reserve Bank of India's (RBI) directive to banks to provide Interoperable Cardless Cash Withdrawal (ICCW) services. The new facility will guard against cloning, impersonation, and fraud. For each transaction, it creates a unique QR code. Customers can only use the ATM UPI service twice per day per account, with a daily limit of ₹ 5,000.

Tata Group Signs \$1.6 Billion EV Battery Plant Deal In Gujarat:-

The Tata group inked an outline agreement with the Gujarat government to establish a lithium-ion cell manufacturing for approximately Rs 13,000 crore (\$1.6 billion). The initiative coincides with India's efforts to establish its own electric vehicle (EV) supply chain. The decision to build the EV battery plant in Sanand, Gujarat, was made at a Tata Sons board meeting earlier. Tata Motors already operates a plant in Sanand and has acquired the adjacent Ford Motors plant. The integration of the two factories has begun, and it could take up to a year to complete.

India Conducts Asia's First Demonstration Of Performance-Based Navigation For Helicopters:-

According to civil aviation minister Jyotiraditya Scindia, India completed Asia's first demonstration of performance-based navigation for helicopters on a flight from Juhu in Mumbai to Pune utilising GAGAN satellite technology. GAGAN — GPS Aided GEO Augmented Navigation — is a cutting-edge space-based augmentation system that improves the accuracy of GPS navigation system output by giving local geographical positioning for greater aircraft location precision and more efficient traffic management.
