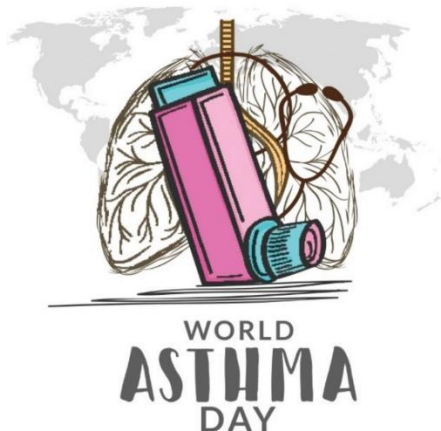

World Asthma Day (First Tuesday of May) : 02 May:-

Every year on the first Tuesday of May, World Asthma Day is observed. The Global Initiative for Asthma (GINA), a World Health Organisation collaborative organisation created in 1993, organises it. The day is observed to increase awareness about asthma and its management across the world. This year, World Asthma Day is observed on May 02. The first World Asthma Day, in 1998, was celebrated in more than 35 countries in conjunction with the first World Asthma Meeting held in Barcelona, Spain. GINA has chosen "Asthma Care for All" as the theme for the 2023 World Asthma Day.

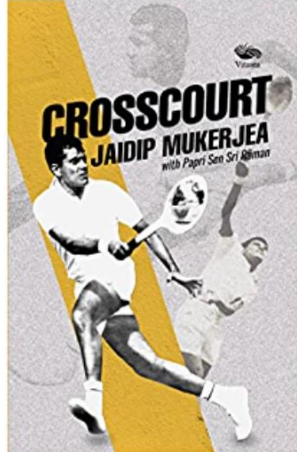


Andhra Pradesh CM Lays Foundation Stone For MulapetaPort:-

Y S Jagan Mohan Reddy, Chief Minister of Andhra Pradesh, has laid the groundwork for the Rs 4,362 crore Mulapeta greenfield port in Srikakulam district. In addition to the port, the Chief Minister lay the groundwork for a fishing harbour at Budagatlapalem, a life irrigation project from Gotta barrage to Hira Mandalam reservoir, and the continuation of

MahendraTanaya river works. Reddy stated that the Mulapeta Port in Sonthabommali mandal would be finished in 24 months and that the seaport has the ability to directly and indirectly employ 35,000 people.

SharminMukerjea, Mukerjea's wife, was instrumental in encouraging and aiding him in writing the book. 2023 Men's Hockey Asian Champions Trophy to be Held in Chennai:-

The Asian Champions Trophy 2023 hockey event will be hosted in Chennai, India, from August 3 to August 12, according to Hockey India (HI). For the first time, the Asian Champions Trophy, now in its seventh edition, will be held in Chennai. It will also be the first international hockey tournament staged in Chennai since the Asia Cup in 2007. The tournament

will also act as a warm-up for the Indian men's hockey squad ahead of the Asian Games, which will be held in Hangzhou, China, in September and October.

Deepika Misra becomes 1st Indian Air Force woman officer to get Gallantry Award:-

Wing Commander Deepika Misra became the Indian Air Force's first female officer to receive a gallantry award. Wing Commander Misra, a helicopter pilot from Rajasthan, was awarded the Vayu Sena Medal (Gallantry) for her "exceptional courage" during a flood rescue mission in Madhya Pradesh and Rajasthan. Deepika Misra was awarded the Vayu Sena Medal by IAF Chief Air Chief Marshal VR Chaudhari. She assisted in the rescue of 47 people during last year's floods in Madhya Pradesh and Rajasthan.

Gary Ballance Retires From All Forms Of Cricket:-

Gary Ballance recently declared his retirement from all kinds of cricket. After signing a two-year contract with Zimbabwe, the left-handed hitter made his debut. Ballance represented Zimbabwe in one Test, one Twenty20 International, and five One-Day Internationals. In addition, he has five Test hundreds, one of which (137) came against the West Indies. Ballance made his Test debut in 2014 and has since appeared in 23 Tests for England. However, his career began to

decline after 2017. Ballance was accused of using racist comments at Azeem Rafiq, a player from Yorkshire. Ballance relocated to Zimbabwe in order to resurrect his career.

FIFA: Argentina To Replace Indonesia As Under-20 World Cup Host:-

Following the decision to remove Indonesia of the right to host the under-20 World Cup, FIFA announced that Argentina will host the tournament. On March 29, FIFA announced the decision to remove Indonesia as the host country after the country's FA cancelled the draw scheduled for Bali due to the governor's refusal to accept Israel's team. Argentina hosted the Under-20 World Cup in 2001, winning the fourth of its six titles. It is also attempting to co-host the 2030 World Cup finals with Uruguay, Chile, and Paraguay.

Global Unicorn Index 2023: India Emerges As Third-Largest Hub With 68 Unicorns:-

According to Hurun's Global Unicorn Index 2023, India has held its third place as the country with the most unicorns worldwide, trailing only the United States and China. India behind the United States and China, which have 666 and 316 new unicorns, respectively. Since the pandemic began, India has added 14 new unicorns. Despite their success, none of

the start-ups entered the top ten. According to the survey, BYJU's valuation is the highest in India, at \$22 billion, followed by Swiggy and Dream11, both valued at \$8 billion.

Sebi Introduces ASBA-Like Facility For Secondary Market Trading In India:-

The board of market regulator Sebi approved an ASBA-like facility for trading in the secondary market for investors. Under the proposed framework, stock brokers will be able to directly settle brokerage payments with UPI clients, or they can use CC's capacity to have the standard rate of brokerage taken from the clients' UPI block. The ASBA-like feature, according to SEBI, will be optional for both investors and stock brokers. According to SEBI, the framework would be implemented in stages to ensure a smooth transition in the market.

Cuba's President Miguel Diaz-Canel wins a second term:-

Despite the communist-run island's dire economic situation, Cuban President Miguel Diaz-Canel has been re-elected for a second five-year term by the country's National Assembly. The reelection of Diaz-Canel by the 470-member Assembly was widely anticipated. In 2018, he succeeded Raul Castro as president, and in 2021, he took over as First Secretary of

the Cuban Communist Party. Since becoming president, Diaz-Canel, a 62-year-old electrical engineer by training, has encountered a string of disasters that have brought Cuba even closer to economic catastrophe.
