

DAILY UPDATE 1 :IMPORTANT DAY



Good Governance Day (India) :25 December :-

Every year on December 25, Good Governance Day is observed. The purpose of the day is to inform citizens, particularly students, who are the future of the country, about the government's responsibilities and duties. The day is also celebrated to commemorate the birth anniversary of India's former Prime Minister, Atal Bihari Vajpayee. On December 23, 2014, Atal Bihari Vajpayee and Pandit Madan Mohan Malaviya (posthumously) were announced as recipients of India's highest civilian award, Bharat Ratna.

Mbappe beats Messi To Win Golden Boot In World Cup:-

Kylian Mbappe will go down in history as the winner of the FIFA World Cup 2022 golden boot. Mbappe scored a hat-trick in the final to beat out club teammate Lionel Messi for the coveted golden boot. However, his hat-trick was insufficient for the French team to defend their title, as they were defeated 2-4 on penalties by Argentina. Mbappe's first goal of the tournament came in France's opening game, a 4-1 victory over Australia. He then scored both goals in a 2-1 win over Denmark but was held scoreless in a 1-0 loss to Tunisia.

India hockey team win's Women's FIH Nations Cup 2022:-

The Indian Women's Hockey Team won the FIH Women's Nations Cup 2022 in Valencia, Spain, defeating Spain 1-0 in the final. Indian went undefeated throughout the tournament and was also promoted to the FIH Hockey Women's Pro League for 2023-24. The Women's FIH Nations Cup was held for the first time this season, with the winner earning a spot in next year's Women's Pro League. Hockey India has set aside Rs 2 lakh for each player and Rs 1 lakh for each member of the Indian Women's Hockey Team's support staff.

Iran Removed From UN Commission On The Status Of Women:-

Iran was expelled from the United Nations Commission on the Status of Women (UNCSW) in an unprecedented move in which India abstained. At the UN Economic and Social Council, the US proposal to remove Iran from the panel received 29 votes, with eight votes against and 16 abstentions in the 54-member elected body. The vote came after intense lobbying by the United States in response to widespread protests in Iran sparked by outrage over the edict requiring women to wear hijabs.

Tokyo Makes Solar Panels Mandatory For New Homes Built After 2025:-

The Japanese capital's local assembly has passed a new regulation requiring all new houses built in Tokyo by large-scale homebuilders after April 2025 to include solar panels to reduce household carbon emissions. Japan currently ranks fifth among the world's largest carbon emitters. According to a report, this new regulation for new built homes requires about 50 major builders to equip homes of up to 2,000 square metres (21,500 square feet) with renewable energy power sources, primarily solar panels.

Tata Steel Officially Partnered FIH Men's World Cup 2023:-

Tata Steel Limited has signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with Hockey India to become an official partner of the FIH Odisha Hockey Men's World Cup 2023. The 15th edition of the prestigious event, the top tournament for men alongside the Olympics, will be held in Bhubaneswar and Rourkela from January 13 to January 29, 2023. The FIH Odisha Hockey Men's World Cup will be held for the fourth time in India, following events in 1982 in Bombay, 2010 in New Delhi, and 2018 in Bhubaneswar.

EV Yatra Mobile Application Launched:-

President Droupadi Murmu launched the 'EV Yatra' web portal and mobile phone application to promote the use of electric vehicles in the country. To make EV usage more convenient, India's Bureau of Energy Efficiency developed the EV Yatra mobile app. The app allows users to locate the nearest EV charging station and reserve a charging slot. The app is now available for download from the Google Play Store and the Apple App Store. EV users use this mobile application to find public EV charging stations when they need them.

Rehan Ahmed Becomes England's Youngest Cricketer To Debut In Test Cricket:-

Rehan Ahmed, 18, became England's youngest Test cricketer when he made his debut in the third Test against Pakistan. Rehan has also broken Brian Close's record of making his Test debut at the age of 18 years 149 days, having done so at the age of 18 years 126 days. Rehan has a high score of 122 and picked nine wickets in three first class matches. Ahmed was one of two changes made by the England team as the visitors are looking at a historic 3-0 series sweep over Pakistan and a ninth Test win in 10 games since Ben Stokes became captain and Brendon McCullum head coach.

India Received Rafale's 36th And Last Aircraft From France:-

India has received all 36 Rafale aircraft from France, with the last aircraft landing in the country recently. According to the Indian Air Force, the aircraft arrived after a quick en-route mid-air refuelling from a UAE Air Force tanker aircraft, after taking off from France. India and France had signed the inter-government agreement in 2016, under which Paris agreed to provide 36 Rafale fighter jets at a cost of around 60,000 crore rupees to India. The first batch of five Rafale jets had arrived on 29th July, 2020.

Cindy Hook Named As CEO Of 2032 Olympic Organising Committee:-

Cindy Hook, an American executive, has been named the inaugural CEO of the organising committee for the 2032 Olympic and Paralympic Games in Brisbane. The appointment was announced by the organising committee after six months of interviews with 50 candidates. Hook had previously worked for the international professional services network in the United States and Australia, moving to Sydney in 2009 to lead the auditing practise for six years before becoming CEO of the Australian operation in 2015.
