DAILY UPDATE 1 :IMPORTANT DAY



AntyodayaDiwas :25 September :-

Every year on September 25, AntyodayaDiwas is observed. This day was given national significance when Prime Minister Narendra Modi dedicated it in 2014 to late Pandit DeenDayal Upadhyaya to commemorate his birth anniversary. Pandit DeenDayalUpadhyaya was born in Mathura in 1916 and served the BharatiyaJana Sangh from 1953 to 1968. Under mysterious circumstances, the leader died in February 1968 near Mughalsarai Junction railway station. In 2018, the UP government renamed the railway station "DeenDayal Upadhyaya Junction."

World's First Cloned Arctic Wolf In China:-

Sinogene Biotechnology, based in Beijing, has successfully cloned a wild Arctic wolf for the first time in the world. The cloning of the Arctic wolf, also known as the white wolf or polar wolf, which is native to Canada's Queen Elizabeth Islands' High Arctic tundra, is regarded as a watershed moment in the conservation of rare and endangered species through cloning technology. The wolf named Maya, according to the company, is in good health. The company showed

15YearOld Pranav Anand Becomes India's 76th Chess Grandmaster:-

Pranav Anand of Bengaluru became India's 76th Grandmaster after passing the 2,500 Elo mark at the World Youth Chess Championship in Mamaia, Romania. The 15-year-old earned the title after meeting all of the other requirements for GM. He defeated France's Augustin Droin to win the U-14 Open with 9 points from 11 rounds, just a day after becoming India's 76th Grandmaster. He earned his previous two GM norms earlier this year, at the Sitges Open in January and the Vezerkepso GM Round Robin in March.

India Ratings Cuts FY23 GDP Growth Forecast To 6.9%:-

India Ratings reduced its forecast from 7% to 6.9%, joining other institutions in lowering their projections to less than 7% since the release of April-June GDP data. "Despite private final consumption expenditure (PFCE) and gross fixed capital formation (GFCF) growth coming in better than our expectations in Q1, the agency expects the slowdown in the growth of government final consumption expenditure (GFCE) and worsening of net exports to weigh on the FY23 GDP growth,"

DAILY UPDATE 5 :NATIONAL**Health Minister Dr Mansukh Mandaviya Launched Raktdaan Amrit Mahotsav:-**

On the occasion of Prime Minister Narendra Modi's birthday, Union Health Minister Mansukh Mandaviya recently launched a 15-day blood donation drive. Mandaviya also gave blood at a blood donation camp set up at Safdarjung Hospital. The minister urged citizens to sign up for the AarogyaSetu app or the e-Raktkosh portal in order to donate blood as part of the 'Raktdaan Amrit Mahotsav,' which will run until October 1 – National Voluntary Blood Donation Day. According to an official, 5,857 camps have been approved across the country, and 55,8959 donors have registered.

DAILY UPDATE 6 :SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY**Delhi Police Became First Force To Make Collection Of Forensic Evidence Mandatory:-**

The Delhi Police have become the first in the country to make the collection of forensic evidence mandatory in crimes punishable by more than six years in prison. The order came hours after Union Home Minister Amit Shah paid a visit to the Police Headquarters. Delhi Police Commissioner Sanjay Arora issued a "standard order" to all police units which said, "In order to take conviction rate higher and integrate the criminal justice system with forensic science investigation, it

has been decided to use forensic tools mandatorily in all cases where punishment provided is more than six years.”

Election Commission Of India Launched BLO E-Patrika:-

At an interactive session with BLOs from across the country, the Election Commission of India released a new digital publication called 'BLO e-Patrika.' Over 350 Booth Level Officers (BLOs) joined via video-conferencing from the offices of Chief Electoral Officers (CEOs) in states/UTs, and 50 BLOs from neighbouring states of Rajasthan, Uttar Pradesh, and Delhi attended the launch event in person at the India Habitat Centre in New Delhi. The event marked the Commission's first-ever direct interaction with BLOs across the country.

Prime Minister Narendra Modi congratulated Angolan President Joao Manuel Goncalves Lourenco on his re-election. Angola is a valued African friend of India, and the two countries have warm and friendly people-to-people ties. With President Joao Lourenco securing a second five-year term, bilateral trade relations between India and Angola are expected to improve.
