### DAILY UPDATE 1 :APPOINTMENT



#### **Vinod Aggarwal Elected As New President Of SIAM:-**

Vinod Aggarwal, MD & CEO, Volvo Eicher Commercial Vehicles Ltd (VECV), has been elected as the new president of the Society of Indian Automobile Manufacturers (SIAM) for the fiscal year 2022-23. Aggarwal succeeds Kenichi Ayukawa, executive vice chairman and sole director of Maruti Suzuki India Ltd. "The Indian automotive industry is currently at a very exciting juncture. #### **Figma Design Platform Acquired By Adobe For \$20 Billion:-**

Adobe Inc recently agreed to acquire Figma, whose products are used by software developers to collaborate, for \$20 billion, raising investor concerns about the high price tag, causing the Photoshop maker's market value to fall by more than \$30 billion. Adobe CEO Shantanu Narayen called Figma's business "the future of work" and said there were "tremendous opportunities" to combine it with his company's other products, such as document reader Acrobat and online whiteboard Figjam.
