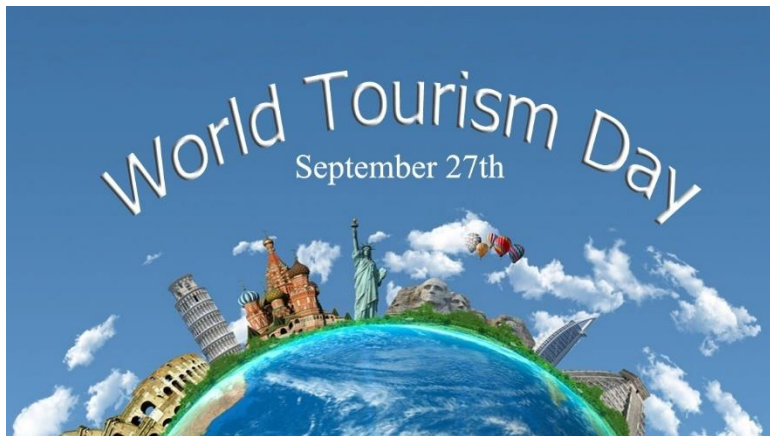

### **World Tourism Day :27 September :-**

Every year on September 27, the world celebrates World Tourism Day. On this day in 1970, the United Nations World Tourism Organization's Statutes were adopted, which are regarded as a watershed moment in global tourism. This paved the way for the establishment of the UN World Tourism Organization five years later. On September 27, 1980, the United Nations World Tourism Organization (UNWTO) observed the first World Tourism Day as an international observance. The theme of World Tourism Day 2022 is 'Rethinking Tourism'.

### **Andaman And Nicobar Islands Become India's First Swachh Sujal Pradesh:-**

Gajendra Singh Shekhawat, Union Jal Shakti Minister, has declared Andaman and Nicobar Islands to be India's first Swachh Sujal Pradesh. He presented the certificate to Lieutenant Governor Admiral DK Joshi at a function in Port Blair.

With this achievement, all villages on the Andaman and Nicobar Islands have been certified as ODF plus open defecation free and have received the Har Ghar Jal certification. The Union Minister congratulated everyone on the island on their outstanding achievement.

### Swati Piramal Conferred With Top French Civilian Honour:-

Dr Swati Piramal, a prominent Indian scientist and industrialist, has been awarded France's highest civilian honour, the Chevalier de la Legion d'Honneur, or Knight of the Legion of Honour, for her contributions to business and industry, science and medicine, and strengthening Indo-French ties. Piramal, 66, is the vice-chairperson of the Piramal Group, a business conglomerate based in Mumbai that has interests in pharmaceuticals, financial services, real estate, and glass packaging.

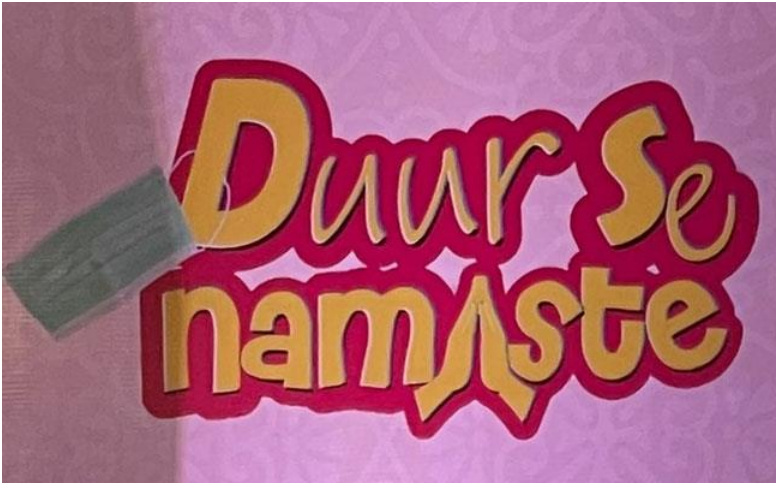


### China And UAE To Join Hands On Moon Rover Missions:-

The Mohammed Bin Rashid Space Centre (MBRSC) of the United Arab Emirates recently announced a partnership with China's space agency to land a rover on the Moon in future lunar missions. The MBRSC revealed in a tweet that the rover

will be delivered to the lunar surface aboard a China National Space Administration (CNSA) lander. The UAE is currently working on launching a rover named Rashid to the Moon later this year as part of the Emirates Lunar Mission in a lander developed by the Japanese company ispace.

### **USAID And UNICEF Launch Series Titled 'Door Se Namaste':-**

At a ceremony in New Delhi, the US Agency for International Development (USAID) and UNICEF launched the Doordarshan and YouTube series titled Door Se Namaste. Door Se Namaste is a new television series that promotes healthy behaviours in the aftermath of a pandemic. It is a fictional Hindi series created in an educational entertainment format that highlights the challenges of a post-pandemic world and encourages the adoption of healthy behaviours and practises. Every Sunday from 11 a.m. to 12 p.m., the show will air.

### **Kashmir Gets Its First Multiplex, In Srinagar:-**

Manoj Sinha, the lieutenant governor of Jammu and Kashmir, inaugurated Kashmir's first multiplex in the Sonwar area of Srinagar. After a three-decade absence, cinemas have returned to Kashmir. "Inaugurated INOX multiplex theatre in

Srinagar. Congratulations to the people, Sh. Vijay Dhar & INOX Group. A major Socio-economic revolution is sweeping through J&K in the last 3 years. It is reflection of a new dawn of hope, dreams, confidence and aspirations of people", Sinha posted on Twitter. INOX designed the multiplex, which has three movie theatres with a total capacity of 520 seats.

### India's 1st Lithium-Ion Cell Factory Inaugurated In Andhra Pradesh:-

Rajeev Chandrasekhar, Minister of State for Electronics and Information Technology, has inaugurated the pre-production run of India's first lithium cell manufacturing facility in Tirupati, Andhra Pradesh. Munoth Industries Limited, based in Chennai, spent Rs 165 crores to build this cutting-edge facility. The plant currently has a capacity of 270 Mwh and can produce 20,000 cells of 10Ah capacity per day. These cells are used in power banks, and their capacity is approximately 60% of India's current requirement.

## DAILY UPDATE 8 : DEFENCE



### Indian Air Force Set To Retire Abhinandan's MiG-21 Squadron:-

According to sources, the Indian Air Force is planning to retire its Srinagar-based MiG-21 squadron 'Sword Arms,' of which Wing Commander Abhinandan Varthaman was a member when he shot down a Pakistani F-16 combat aircraft a day after the Balakot strike in February 2019. 'Sword Arms' is one of the organization's four remaining squadrons of ageing MiG-21 fighter planes. According to defence sources, the No. 51 Squadron will be retired by the end of September, "as planned." According to them, the remaining three MiG-21 squadrons will be phased out by 2025.

## DAILY UPDATE 9 :AGREEMENT



### Google Cloud & Nasscom Tie-Up To Skill Students For Entry-Level Cloud Jobs:-

Google Cloud announced the first cohort of its computing foundations with Kubernetes course, which was developed in collaboration with FutureSkills Prime, an IT Ministry and Nasscom digital skilling initiative. The goal of the beginner-level course is to give participants hands-on experience with cloud computing, cloud basics, big data, and machine learning (ML). The course will provide hands-on training (via the Google Cloud Skills Boost platform) for a variety of career paths such as IT infrastructure, data analytics, and Cloud native application development.

### CM Of Manipur N. Biren Singh Introduce Web Portal 'CM Da Haisi':-

In Manipur, Chief Minister N. Biren Singh launched a web portal in Imphal to receive public complaints and grievances. The web portal is called 'CM Da Haisi' (Inform to CM), and the public can use it to file complaints by logging on to the website. Complainants can also track the progress of their complaints. The Public Grievances Redressal and Anti-Corruption Cell, based at the CM Secretariat, will use the portal to communicate with the relevant departments in order to resolve public grievances within a reasonable time frame.
