World Cancer Day : 04 February:-

World Cancer Day is observed on February 4th to raise awareness of cancer and to encourage its prevention, detection, and treatment. The primary goal of World Cancer Day is to significantly reduce cancer-related illness and death. Cancer is the world's second leading cause of death. World Cancer Day was established in 2000 at the first World Cancer Summit in Paris. The Union for International Cancer Control (UICC) established the Day to support the goals of the World Cancer Declaration, which was written in 2008. The theme of World Cancer Day 2023 is "Close The Care Gap".

India to host India Energy Week 2023 from Feb 6:-

From the 6th to the 8th of February 2023, the Ministry of Petroleum and Natural Gas will hold its flagship energy event "India Energy Week 2023 (IEW)" in Bengaluru at the Bangalore International Exhibition Centre. The inaugural India Energy Week takes place at a critical juncture, with the challenges of energy security and environmental sustainability influencing long-term energy transition and decarbonization pathways. Over the next two decades, India is expected to

have the highest increase in energy demand of any country, as its economy grows and creates opportunities for its people and the global energy value chain.

Sabir Ali, Iron Man of India, passes away at the age of 67:-

Sabir Ali the 'Ironman of India', who won the decathlon gold medal at the Asian Athletics Championships in Tokyo in 1981, died in New Delhi. He was 67. Ali, who retired from Railways, won the title in Tokyo with a total of 7,253 points, defeating Japan's Nobuya Saito (7,078) and China's Zu Qilin (7,074). He also took home two silver medals from the South Asian Federation Games, which were held in Kathmandu and Dhaka. Between 1979 and 1985, Ali won eight consecutive Open National titles in the gruelling event.




Popular Telugu dubbing artist A Srinivasa Murthy passes away:-

A Srinivasa Murthy, a popular Telugu dubbing artist, died in Chennai due to health issues. Hrithik Roshan, an actor, paid tribute to the artist. The late dubbing artist provided voices for Hrithik Roshan's films 'Bang Bang,' 'Krrish,' 'Krrish 3', 'Kaabil,' and 'Dhoom 2'. Srinivasa, the son of veteran playback singer AVN Murthy, began his dubbing career in Tollywood in the early 1990s and, in addition to dubbing for some of the South's biggest stars, has also dubbed in Telugu

for several Bollywood films. He is also known for lending his voice to well-known Tamil actors such as Ajith and Chiyaan Vikram.



First Ever India Stack Developer Conference Held In Delhi:-

On January 25, the first India Stack Developer Conference was held in New Delhi to discover ways and means to ensure wider adoption of India's digital goods around the world. Over 100 digital leaders from industry, government, start-ups and unicorns, and academia attended. G20 delegates and the G20 Secretariat were also invited to the conference. India Stack is a multi-layer cluster of digital solutions such as Aadhaar, UPI, Digi Locker, Co-Win, GeM, and GSTN that have played important roles in India's digital transformation.

India's Services Exports To Cross The Goal Of 300bn \$ In This Financial Year:-

According to Commerce and Industry Minister Piyush Goyal, despite global economic uncertainties the country's services exports are doing "extremely well," and if current trends continue, outbound shipments will grow by about 20% this fiscal year and surpass the \$300 billion mark. He said that on the merchandise front also, exports are so far registering healthy growth despite the world being under recession, huge inflationary pressure and overstocking of various commodities.
