### **DAILY UPDATE 1 : OBITUARIES**



#### **South African cheetah, Uday, translocated to Kuno National Park dies:-**

One of the cheetahs relocated from South Africa to Madhya Pradesh's Kuno National Park (KNP) died. The cheetah 'Uday' was six years old. This is the KNP's second similar event in less than a month. Sasha, a female Cheetah translocated from Namibia, died on March 28. Sasha's death was attributed to a pre-existing kidney condition, which is common in confined Cheetahs. The deaths of two critically endangered Cheetahs within a month have raised major concerns about the long-term viability of the ambitious and unprecedented restoration initiative.

### **DAILY UPDATE 2 :SPORTS**



#### **IPL 2023: Rohit Sharma becomes 4th batter to score 6000 runs in the IPL:-**

Mumbai Indians captain Rohit Sharma made history by becoming only the fourth batsman in Indian Premier League history to score 6000 runs. Rohit reached the milestone during the IPL 2023 match between Sunrisers Hyderabad at Rajiv Gandhi International Stadium in Hyderabad. Rohit currently has 6014 IPL runs from 231 matches, including one

century and 41 half-centuries. Former RCB skipper Virat Kohli leads the leaderboard with 6844 runs in 228 matches. In addition, he made five hundreds and 47 fifties.

## DAILY UPDATE 3:DEFENCE



### **Air Marshal Sandeep Singh appointed Military Advisor to National Security Council:-**

Air Marshal Sandeep Singh, a former Air Force vice chief and ace fighter pilot, has been named the next Military Advisor to the National Security Council. He takes over for General Anil Chauhan, who was named Chief of Defence Staff in October of last year. Singh, an alumni of the National Defence Academy and the National Defence College, retired from the IAF on January 31 after a long career and is noted for his active role in the IAF's modernization. On December 22, 1983, he was commissioned into the IAF as a fighter pilot.

## DAILY UPDATE 4 :SUMMITS AND CONFERENCES



### **3rd Education Working Group Meeting Held In Bhubaneswar:-**

The third Education Working Group meeting under G20 was held in Bhubaneswar, Odisha from April 27-28, 2023. The meeting was a follow-up of the previous two working group meetings, which were conducted in Chennai and Amritsar earlier this year, with the goal of exploring and implementing creative ideas and strategies to globalise the field of education. The three-day summit was attended by about 60 participants from G20 member countries, invitee countries,

and International Organisation countries. Delegates also viewed cutting-edge technologies and new concepts that are changing the way we work and learn at the G20 Future of Work Exhibition.

## DAILY UPDATE 5 :BANKING



### RBI Allows AU Small Finance Bank To Deal With Foreign Exchange:-

The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has granted AU Small Finance Bank Limited (SFB) permission to act as an authorised dealer in foreign exchange, said AU Small Finance Bank. According to a regulatory filing by AU Small Finance Bank, the Reserve Bank has granted Licence to function as Authorized Dealer Category-I (AD-I) under Section 10 of FEMA, 1999 to deal in foreign exchange. The central bank also granted Equitas Small Finance Bank an Authorized Dealer Category-I (AD-I) Licence.

## DAILY UPDATE 6 :SPORTS



### IPL 2023: David Warner Becomes Most Capped Overseas Captain In IPL, Surpasses Adam Gilchrist:-

When David Warner stepped out for the toss for Delhi Capitals versus Kolkata Knight Riders during an IPL 2023 game in Delhi, he became the most capped overseas skipper in IPL history. The 36-year-old Warner surpassed compatriot Adam Gilchrist with his 75th appearance as captain in the IPL. Warner first captained in the IPL during his previous stint with

the Delhi Capitals (then Daredevils) in 2013, when he stood as the stand-in captain for Mahela Jayawardena. Warner was then roped in by Sunrisers Hyderabad in 2014.

## DAILY UPDATE 7 :AWARDS



### **Karnataka Bags National Award For Fasal Bima Yojana:-**

Karnataka has won the national award for the best Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojana (PMFBY) implementation in the fiscal year 2022-23. The PMFBY is a large-scale crop subsidy insurance scheme that was aimed to safeguard the farmers, established in Karnataka in 2016. This scheme is being managed by the Department of Agriculture, Cooperation and Farmers' Welfare, under the Ministry of Agriculture. In Karnataka, PMFBY is being implemented using its own portal, 'Samrakshane,' which was conceived and developed by the state under the National Informatics Centre (NIC).

## DAILY UPDATE 8 : INTERNATIONAL



### **New York Senate Appoints Rowan Wilson As State's First Black Chief Judge:-**

Rowan Wilson was confirmed as New York's first Black chief judge by the state's Senate. His nomination comes two months after lawmakers rejected Governor Kathy Hochul's initial nominee for the office. Since 2017, Mr. Wilson has served as an associate judge on the Court of Appeals, New York's highest court. Ms. Hochul had initially chosen Hector

LaSalle for the highest court job, but he was opposed by liberal senators and supporters who criticised his rulings as an appeals judge.

## DAILY UPDATE 9 :STATE



### **Maha Govt Has Announces 4% Reservation For Divyang Employees In Promotions:-**

The Maharashtra government has announced a 4% reservation in promotions for Divyang personnel. The state cabinet has agreed that this reservation will apply to cadres where the share of direct service recruitment is less than 75 percent. The state cabinet has also decided to clear all pending dues as per the Seventh Pay Commission for non-teaching staff serving across all non-agricultural universities. The arrears will be paid in five installments on 1st July every year, over the next five years.

## DAILY UPDATE 10 :SUMMITS AND CONFERENCES



### **8th India-Thailand Defence Dialogue held in Bangkok:-**

Bangkok hosted the 8th India-Thailand Defence Dialogue. Nivedita Shukla Verma, Special Secretary in the Ministry of Defence, co-chaired the meeting with General NuchitSribunsong, Thailand's Deputy Permanent Secretary for Defence. During the dialogue, they reviewed the defence cooperation between the two countries and explored new

initiatives to further strengthen bilateral engagements. Both sides also exchanged views on regional and global issues of shared interest. India and Thailand share a strategic partnership and defence is a key pillar of this cooperation.
