IIT Kanpur Develops Artificial Heart To Deal With Acute Cardiac Problems:-

IIT Kanpur has developed an artificial heart that will be of great assistance to people suffering from acute cardiac problems. Abhay Karandikar, Director of IIT Kanpur, stated that the animal trials would begin in 2023. He said, "Now heart transplant will be easy. Artificial hearts can be implanted in serious patients. IIT Kanpur and cardiologists from across the country have developed this artificial heart. Trial on animals will start from February or March. After success in the trial, transplantation can be done in humans in the next two years."

CJI D Y Chandrachud Constituted Committee To Conduct Accessibility Audit Of SC Premises:-

Chief Justice of India D Y Chandrachud has formed a committee headed by apex court judge Justice S Ravindra Bhat to conduct an audit of the top court premises' "physical and functional access" to make them more accessible to the disabled. The 'Supreme Court Committee on Accessibility' has been given a broad mandate to prepare and distribute a questionnaire for persons with disabilities who visit the top court premises, including apex court employees, advocates, litigants, and interns, to assess the nature and extent of problems they face.

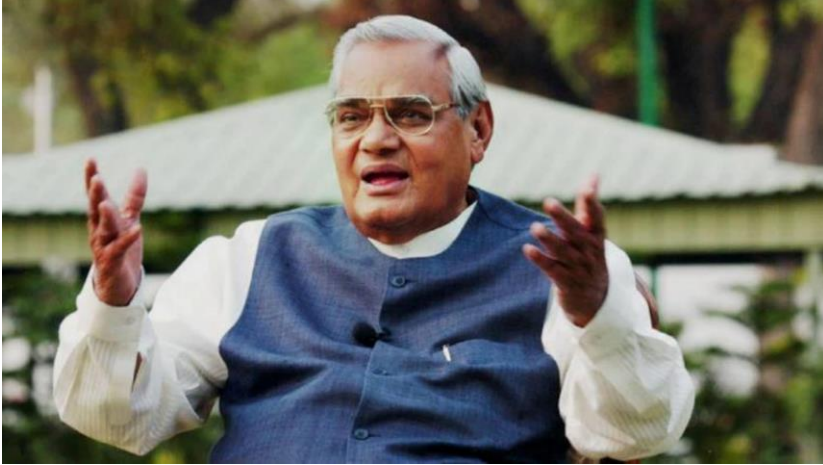


Govt Organizes "Dance To Decarbonize" Event To Generate Power By Dance Floor:-

Madhya Pradesh Govt To Build Atal Bihari Vajpayee's Grand Memorial In Gwalior:-

According to an official, the Madhya Pradesh government has allotted 4,050 hectares of land to build a memorial to former Prime Minister Atal Bihari Vajpayee in his birthplace of Gwalior. According to Gwalior Divisional Commissioner Deepak Singh, approximately 4,050 hectares of land have been allotted for the construction of a memorial to Vajpayee in the Sirol area, in accordance with the proposal submitted by the district collector. Vajpayee was born in Gwalior on December 25, 1924. In the late 1990s and early 2000s, he led the BJP to power at the Centre and served as India's prime minister for six years.

FIFA Chosed Morocco To Host Club World Cup In February 2023:-

FIFA awarded Morocco the hosting rights for the next Club World Cup in February, with an expanded 32-team edition scheduled to begin in 2025. From February 1 to 11, the traditional seven-team tournament will feature European champion Real Madrid, South American champion Flamengo, and Seattle Sounders, the first CONCACAF Champions

League winner from the United States. Following Morocco's stirring run to the World Cup semifinals in Qatar, FIFA's ruling council has decided that the country will host the next global football event in six weeks.

India To Become \$10-Trillion Economy By 2035: CEBR:-

According to the Centre for Economics and Business Research (CEBR), a reputable UK consultancy, India now appears unstoppable in its momentum to become the world's third economic superpower. It expects to be the third largest economy by 2037. CEBR is one of the UK's leading economics consultancies, and its annual publication 'World Economic League Table' tracks global and country-level macroeconomic developments. It forecasts for 191 countries until 2037. The most recent edition of the report also warned that the world is on the verge of a recession.

Jio users in these cities were invited to the Jio Welcome Offer beginning December 26. Gudivada Amarnath, IT Minister of Andhra Pradesh, and K. S. Jawahar Reddy, Chief Secretary of the Government of Andhra Pradesh, attended Jio's 5G launch event in the state, where the telco demonstrated the benefits of 5G in the field of healthcare, using the Jio Community Clinic medical kit and its AR-VR device, Jio Glass.

Piyush Goyal, Minister of Food and Consumer Affairs, recently launched a slew of new initiatives, including a right-to-repair portal and an NTH mobile app, as well as a new National Consumer Helpline centre in Delhi. The Consumer Affairs Department and IIT (BHU), Varanasi have signed an MoU and launched a consumer commission capacity building programme. Manufacturers will share the manual of product details with customers on the 'right to repair' portal so that they can repair themselves or by third parties rather than rely on original manufacturers.
