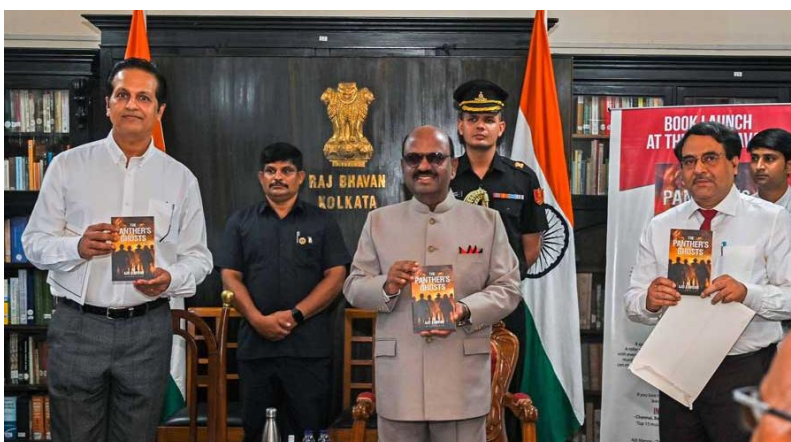
DAILY UPDATE 1 :IMPORTANT DAY

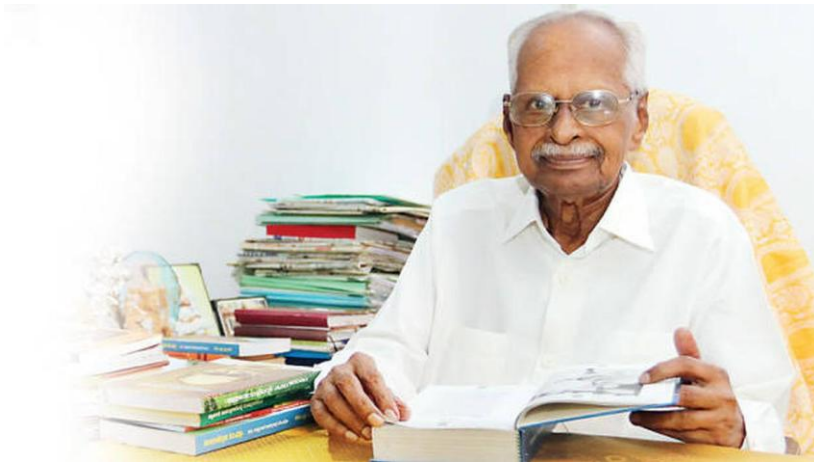


Book 'The Panther's Ghosts: The Beginning', Launched at Raj Bhavan:-

He achieved fame through his own efforts and worked as a teacher and educator. He also possessed postgraduate degrees in Malayalam, English, and Hindi, as well as PG diplomas in Telugu, Kannada, and Tamil.

Espionage case: Judicial custody of DRDO scientist now till June 12:-

Pradeep Kurulkar (59), the DRDO scientist detained on espionage charges by the Maharashtra Anti Terrorism Squad (ATS), has had his judicial detention extended to June 12 by a special court in Pune. Kurulkar (59) was apprehended by the ATS on May 3. He was charged with espionage and improper communication with Pakistani intelligence personnel under the Official Secrets Act (OSA) in a suspected honey trap case. Kurulkar had visited various other nations, according to ATS, and it was being investigated whether he met Pakistani operatives during these journeys.

Ummalaneni to head DRDO missiles and strategic systems:-

He has worked on aircraft, helicopters, and was a vital member in the development of various missile systems over his 35-year aerospace career. Babu, a mechanical engineering graduate from Andhra University, went on to earn his Master's degree from IIT Kharagpur and his MBA from JNTU.

Industrialist And Philanthropist Karumuttu T Kannan Passes Away At 70:-

Karumuttu T Kannan (70), a well known industrialist and the chairman of Tamil Nadu-based Thiagarajar Mills and an independent member of TVS Motor's board of directors, died in Madurai, Tamil Nadu. Kannan, the son of the late industrialist and philanthropist Karumuttu Thiagarajan Chettiar, who founded the Thiagarajar Mills in 1936, was also a leading educationalist and the president of Thiagarajar College, Madurai. A textile industry veteran, Kannan was a graduate in business administration from Madurai University and had a wide range of experience in the textile industry.

National Workshop on the National e-Vidhan Application (NeVA):-

On May 24th and 25th, 2023, the Ministry of Parliamentary Affairs has organised a two-day National Workshop on the National e-Vidhan Application (NeVA) in the Convention Hall, The Hotel Ashok in New Delhi. The primary goal of this workshop is to encourage all state and union territory legislatures to accept the NeVA platform. NeVA is one of the 44 Mission Mode Projects (MMPs) that are part of the Government of India's "Digital India Programme." Currently, 21 state legislatures have signed a Memorandum of Understanding to implement NeVA.

Bangladesh-US Joint Naval Exercise Held In Chattogram:-

The 'Tiger Shark 40' Joint Bangladesh-US Naval Drill Exercise was recently held at BNS Nirvik in Chattogram. The exercise's goal is to improve both countries' strategic capacities and to share technical and procedural information. According to an official press release from the Bangladesh Inter Services Press Relations (ISPR), the project is being conducted to boost the existing good relations between the two nations' armed forces. The event's Chief Guest was Chattogram Naval Area Commander Rear Admiral Abdullah AL Mamun Chowdhury.

India And Australia Sign Agreements On Migration And Green Hydrogen Task Force:-

Recently, India and Australia signed agreements on migration and mobility partnerships, as well as a Green Hydrogen task group. The Memorandum of Understanding was signed following a bilateral meeting in Sydney between Prime Minister Narendra Modi and his Australian colleague Anthony Albanese. Prime Minister Modi stated in a joint press statement following the meeting that India-Australia relations are built on mutual trust and confidence. He stated that they are having a positive discussion about enhancing strategic cooperation in mining and essential minerals.
