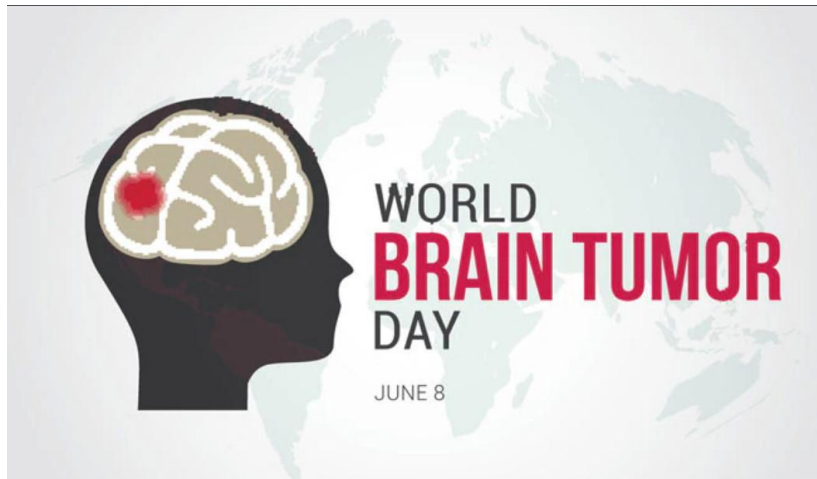

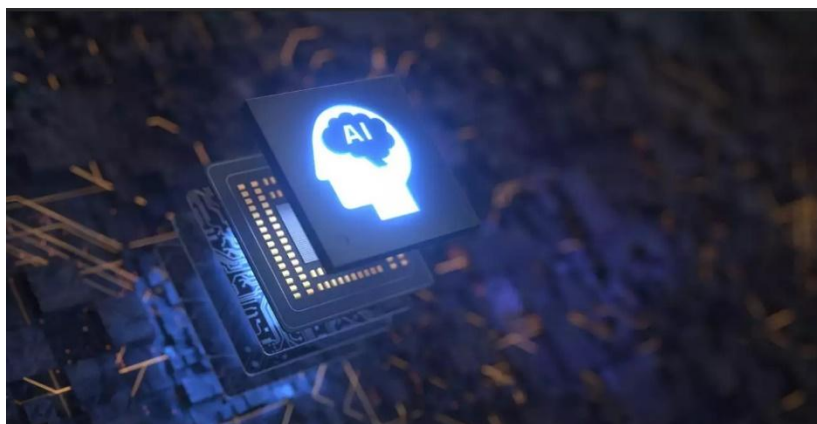

Congress Lok Sabha MP BaluDhanorkar passes away in Delhi:-

Congress leader BaluDhanorkar, the lone Lok Sabha member from Maharashtra, died recently in a private hospital in the National Capital Region. He was 47 years old. Dhanorkar began his political career in the Shiv Sena of Balasaheb Thackeray in Chandrapur district, where he won the assembly election in 2014. He was, however, interested in running for the Lok Sabha seat of Chandrapur, which has traditionally been represented by the BJP's Hansraj Ahir. Dhanorkar became a member of the Congress Party and defeated Ahir.

AI Supercomputer 'AIRAWAT' ranked 75th in the world:-

The AI Supercomputer 'AIRAWAT', which is located at C-DAC in Pune, has been ranked 75th in the world. The 61st edition of the Top 500 Global Supercomputing List was announced during the International Supercomputing Conference (ISC 2023) in Germany. The AIRAWAT supercomputer, installed at the Centre for Development of Advanced Computing (C-DAC) in Pune, Maharashtra, is India's largest and fastest supercomputer, with a peak speed of 13,170 teraflops (Rpeak). As part of the government's National Programme on Artificial Intelligence (AI), the AI system was implemented.

Indian-Origin Sikh Becomes First Turban-Wearing Lord Mayor Of UK City Coventry:-

A local British Sikh councillor in Coventry has made history by becoming the city's first turban-wearing Lord Mayor. Jaswant Singh Birdi, who was born in Punjab and spent some time as a child in West Bengal's Calcutta, moved to Coventry 60 years ago and has been a city councillor for 16 years. Birdi has been involved in the establishment of religious, social, and community projects in Coventry. He takes over as Lord Mayor from Councillor Kevin Maton, while Councillor Mal Mutton has been named Deputy Lord Mayor for the coming year.

1100 FPOs Have Been Allocated To National Cooperative Development Corporation (NCDC):-

With the announcement to construct 1100 new Farmer Producer Organisations (FPOs) in the cooperative sector, the national government's objective of "Sahkar se Samridhi" receives an additional push. The Ministry of Cooperation announced in a statement that "A target of these 1100 additional FPOs has been allocated to the National Cooperative Development Corporation (NCDC) by the Ministry of Agriculture and Farmers' Welfare under its 'Formation and Promotion of 10,000 FPOs' scheme." The government launched FPO in 2020 with a total budgeted cost of Rs. 6865 crore.

Goa Signed MoU With Uttarakhand For Strengthening Tourism Cooperation:-

Officials from the governments of Goa and Uttarakhand have signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) to work together to improve the tourism landscapes of both Goa and Uttarakhand. The MoU is aimed at promoting bilateral cooperation in the travel and tourism sector and facilitating travel between the states to increase the number of tourists visiting Goa and Uttarakhand respectively. The initiative aims to encourage people to witness and experience the rich heritage and vivid culture of India.

Giriraj Singh Launches SAMARTH Campaign To Promote Digital Transactions At Gram Panchayat Level:-

The 'SAMARTH' Campaign has been launched to promote digital transactions across 50,000 gramme panchayats. The campaign's main goal is to promote digital transactions in rural areas, with a particular emphasis on women. Giriraj Singh, Union Minister for Rural Development and Panchayati Raj, launched the campaign in Lucknow and complimented the self-help group for reducing their NPA from 9.58 percent in 2013 to less than 2 percent presently. He recognised BC Sakhis' commitment to the emerging digital economy and stated that India is establishing worldwide standards in women's empowerment.
