DAILY UPDATE 1 :IMPORTANT DAY



PravasiBharatiyaDivas : 09 January:-

PravasiBharatiya Divas (PBD) is observed on January 9 to commemorate Mahatma Gandhi's return to India from South Africa in 1915. The tradition of celebrating PravasiBharatiya Divas began in 2003, when the PBD Convention was organised to recognise the overseas Indian community's contribution to India's development. The PBD Convention format was revised in 2015, and it has been held every two years since then. The theme for this year's PBD is "Diaspora: Reliable Partners for India's Progress in Amrit Kaal".

Baskar Babu Re-Appointed As Suryoday Bank's Chief For 3 Years:-

The Reserve Bank of India has approved Baskar Babu Ramachandran's reappointment as MD & CEO of Suryoday Small Finance Bank for a three-year term beginning January 23, 2023. The bank was founded in Chennai in 2008 as Suryoday Micro Finance Pvt Ltd, and in 2015 it was converted into a public limited company as Suryoday Micro Finance Ltd. The

RBI granted Suryoday Micro Finance in-principle and final approval to establish an SFB in letters dated October 7, 2015 and August 26, 2016, respectively.

Bangladesh PM Sheikh Hasina Inaugurates First-Ever Metro Service In Dhaka:-

Dhaka, Bangladesh's capital and one of the world's most crowded cities, now has its first metro rail system. Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina recently inaugurated a section of the urban rail project known as Line 6. For the time being, the line connects Dhaka's northern zone to a central hub of government offices and hospitals. Dhaka residents are concerned about traffic congestion. According to media reports, it wastes approximately 3.2 million working hours per day and costs the Bangladeshi economy billions of dollars annually.

The state medical education department has launched a new e-health initiative in collaboration with the Centre for Development of Advanced Computing (CDAC). Patient registration, admission, discharge, ambulance, food, medicines, details and availability of doctors are all available online through the new initiative's E-Sushrut HMIS software.

Uttarakhand Govt To Set Up World-Class Kayaking-Canoeing Academy In Tehri:-

RK Singh, Union Minister of Power and New and Renewable Energy, announced the establishment of a world-class Kayaking-Canoeing Academy in Tehri, Uttarakhand. Speaking at the inauguration of the National Championship "Tehri

Water Sports Cup" at Tehri Lake, he declared that sports promotion is the Union Government's top priority. The state Chief Minister, Pushkar Singh Dhami, stated that this is the first time a national-level sports competition has been held at Tehri Lake. He stated that Tehri Lake is quickly becoming an international tourism destination.

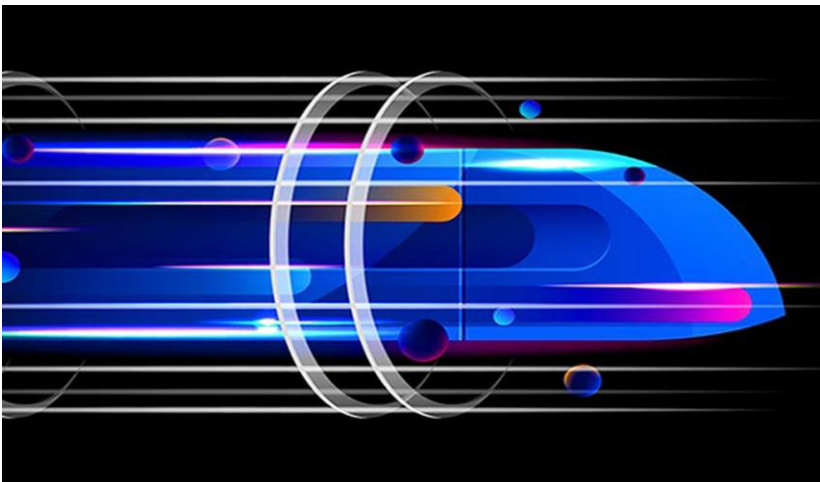

Bharat Biotech's Nasal Vaccine 'INCOVACC' To Be Available At Rs 325 For Govt Hospitals:-

Bharat Biotech has announced that iNCOVACC, a nasal vaccine against Covid-19, will be available to the public in the fourth week of January. The vaccine will cost 800 rupees in private markets and 325 rupees in government markets, according to the Hyderabad-based biotechnology firm. INCOVACC by Bharat Biotech is the world's first intranasal Covid vaccine to be approved for both the primary 2-dose schedule and a heterologous booster dose. Bharat Biotech collaborated with Washington University in the United States to develop iNCOVACC.

Tata Steel, TuTr Hyperloop Collaborate For Developing Hyperloop Technology:-

Tata Steel and TuTr Hyperloop signed a Memorandum of Agreement (MoA) at IIT Madras to collaborate on the development and scale-up of Hyperloop technology. Hyperloop is a future option for high-speed, low-cost, and environmentally friendly transportation for both passengers and cargo. Tubes, pods, propulsion systems, and track are

key components of the hyperloop system. Autonomous, levitated pods travel through an evacuated tube network. It promises ten times the energy efficiency of road transportation and aviation.

Maharashtra Became The First State In The Country To Pass The LokayuktaBill:-

The Lokayukta Bill 2022 was recently passed by the Maharashtra Assembly. Devendra Fadnavis, deputy Chief Minister of Maharashtra, stated that Maharashtra will be the first state in India to introduce and pass the Lokayukta bill. Interestingly, the bill was passed without any debate or absence of Opposition. According to the draft bill, prior Assembly approval is required, and the motion must be brought before the House in its current session before any inquiry against the Chief Minister can begin.

DAILY UPDATE 10 :INTERNATIONAL



Benjamin Netanyahu Sworn In As The Prime Minister Of Israel For A Record 6th Time:-

Benjamin Netanyahu was sworn in as Israel's prime minister for the sixth time recently. Netanyahu, 73, is already Israel's longest-serving Prime Minister, with the backing of 63 lawmakers in the 120-member Knesset (Israeli parliament). In the House, 54 lawmakers voted against his administration. He returned as prime minister with the formation of his sixth

government, which includes a number of far-right allies, a prospect that many fear will pit the new government against large segments of its own population as well as its closest allies abroad.
