Sharp has "devoted more than 25 years of his career to promoting inclusive and sustainable development internationally, bringing experience he has acquired at the United Nations and externally to this new position". Prior to joining the United Nations, Sharp began his career in development with the international non-profit CARE International in Zimbabwe

He is a published author of works in health economics and was a United States Agency for International Development (USAID) 'policy champion' as well as a nominee for the UNDP administrator's award. Sharp holds a postgraduate diploma in HIV/AIDS management from the National Medical University of South Africa and Stellenbosch University in South Africa.

This day also marks the day when Mahatma Gandhi became lifetime Chairman of the All India Nature Cure Foundation Trust and signed the deed with the object of making the benefits of Nature Cure available to all classes of people in the year 1945.

4.) India's first dedicated fisheries business incubator has been inaugurated in which place ?

Explanation : Inaugurating the country's first-of-its kind, dedicated business fisheries incubator in Haryana's Gurugram, Union Minister of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying, Parshottam Rupala said it will serve as a 'milestone' for the fisheries sector promoted under the central flagship Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana PMMSY. Costing Rs 3.23 crore, the incubator — to be known as LINAC- NCDC Fisheries Business Incubation Centre (LIFIC) — will help nurture fisheries startups under real market-led conditions.

The National Cooperative Development Corporation (NCDC), an implementing agency for the LIFIC, has identified the first batch of 10 incubatees from four states — Bihar, Himachal Pradesh, Gujarat and Maharashtra. Out of them, six are from newly created Fish Farmers Producer Organisations with the support of the financial grant under the PMMSY.

The 82nd edition of the All India Presiding Officers' Conference will be held in Shimla, Himachal Pradesh on November 17 and November 18 to commemorate the centennial year of AIPOC. The first conference had also taken place in Shimla in 1921. The President of All India Presiding Officers' Conference and Lok Sabha Speaker Om Birla inaugurated the conference

The two-day All India Presiding Officers' Conference in Shimla will be attended by a total of 378 dignitaries, including 288 presiding officers of 36 state assemblies.

McKinsey & Co, an institution that examines the national balance sheets of ten countries having over 60% of the global income underscored in its latest report. A surge in the net worth was noted from \$156 trillion in 2000 to \$514 trillion in 2020.

China accounted for almost one-third of the increase as its wealth escalated to \$120 trillion from \$7 million in 2000. The net worth of the United States has doubled over this period to \$90 trillion.

Biden's coronavirus relief plan included \$31 billion for tribal communities, and the administration also has worked closely with tribal leaders to help make COVID-19 vaccination rates among Native Americans among the highest in the country.
